In accordance with instructions of the 7th of April, 1880, from the Honorable Secretary of War, the boundaries of the existing Military Reservation of Fort Snelling, are hereby announced, as follows, (Eastman's survey,) viz :

Beginning at a point where the South line of the North-East quarter of the North-East quarter of Section thirty-two (32), Township twenty-eight (28), North of Range twenty-three (23), West of the fourth (4th) principal Meridian, intersects the middle of the main channel of the Minnesota River; thence West to the South-West corner of the North-West quarter of the North-West quarter of Section thirty-two (32), Town and Range aforesaid; thence North to the North-West corner of Section twenty (20), Town and Range aforesaid; thence East to the middle of the main channel of the Mississippi River; thence along the main channel of the Mississippi River, and the confluence of the Mississippi and Minnesota Rivers at the head of Pike Island, and the middle of the Minnesota River to the place of beginning.
