That's why I played the records - because after was through that my type writer I don't want to use my eyes for reading. I played the Woodworth poems (read by Sir Cedric) several times - see Aug. 29

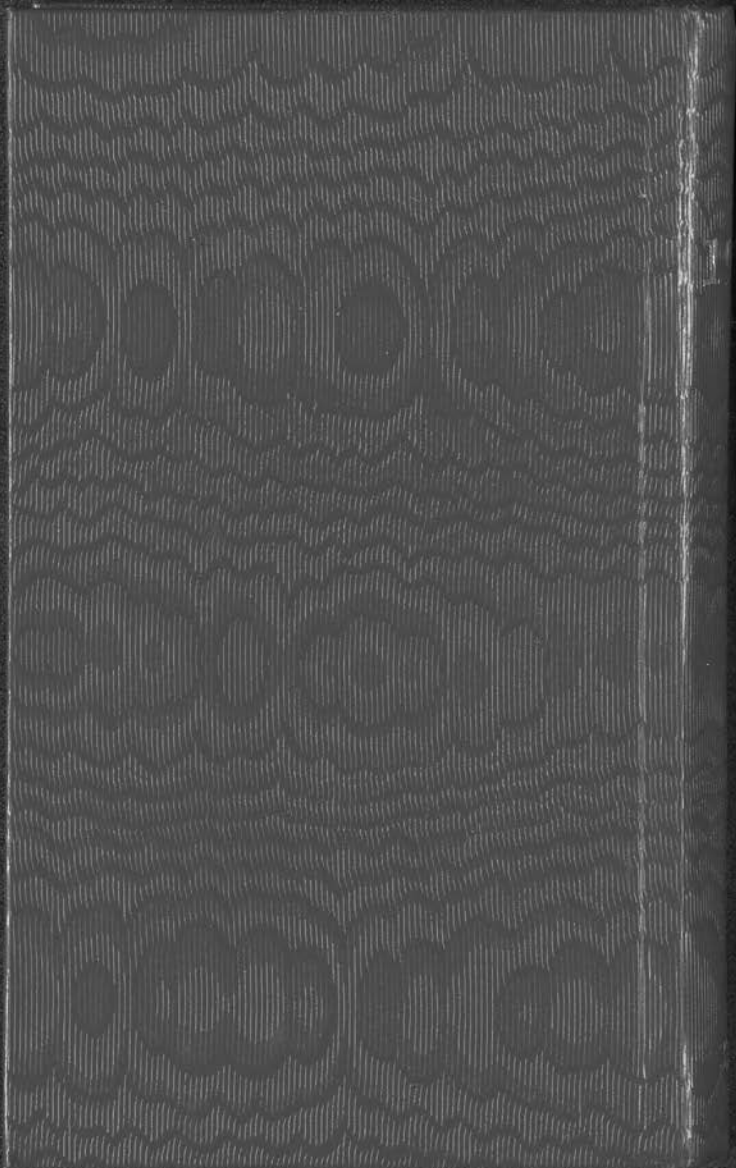
