Special Handling—Fourth class matter only. Parcels of fourth class matter indorsed "Special Handling" will be given the most expeditious handling, transportation and delivery practicable (but not special delivery) upon payment, in addition to the regular postage, of the following charge: up to 2 lbs., 25c; over 2 lbs. up to 10 lbs., 35c; over 10 lbs., 50c.

Registered Mail (postage extra)—60c to \$2.00 including indemnity of \$10 to \$1,000. Declaration of value must be made to P. O.—not on article. 10c fee charged for return receipt for domestic registered mail when requested at time of mailing.

Special Delivery (postage extra)—First class to 2 lbs., 30c; over 2 lbs. to 10 lbs., 45c; over 10 lbs., 60c.  
Other classes—to 2 lbs., 55c; over 2 lbs. to 10 lbs., 65c; over 10 lbs., 80c.
