- ① Bishop Remington laying the cornerstone of St. Ambrose - 1955
- ② This looks like a photo taken for one of the local papers when Calbrillo came out in 1958. Lady on Delos' left is Cor (or looks an awful lot like) Betty Clarke, who was a very good friend.
- ③ The Claremont Inn was a lovely place - we used to go there for Sunday dinner. I'm sure Georgina will remember it.
- ④ Beautiful shot of St. Ambrose
- ⑤ Will Rattenbury was one of their first Claremont friends, I think Scott O'Dell's wife, Dorcas, was his daughter.
- ⑥ Ada Belle McCleery was another old Claremont friend.
- ⑦ Kathy and Dick Topkins and their kids lived next door. Kathy was a writer, and she and Maud were very close.
- ⑧ Paige and Edna Cavanaugh, who were very good friends. Probably taken at their house

in Orange.

- (9) Maud, Kathleen and Helen, late '50s. Could be in front of the Fowlers' mobile home.
- (10) Maud, probably in the '50s. Could be at Cavanaghs'. I'm just including it because it's such a beautiful one.
- (11) I. to v., Frank Fowler; Al (Frank and Helen's adopted son); Cathy, Al and Patsy Fowler's daughter; Patsy, Al's wife; Frankie, Al and Patsy's son. I'd say mid '60s.
- (12) Patsy and Cathy in the living room at 774 West 8<sup>th</sup> Street - a couple of years earlier than (11)?
- (13) Just a nice shot of Maud and Delos. (The Couants were good friends from Garden City.)

14A-14E

All taken by me in living room and dining room at West 8<sup>th</sup> Street, either 1960 or 1964, probably on a couple of different days. Thought you'd like to see more of the inside of the house. In E, you've got the Brass Bowl on top of the record player (a better shot of it

is in (12); and the table from Betsy and Joe's first apartment. In D, Stella's rocker. In A, he seems to be unwrapping something to put on the table that looks so beautiful in B!

(15) Here you have me and Bert with Delos at the big picnic table in the back yard. Probably '64.

(16) A treasure - from left, Tab Lloyd (Cub) and his wife, Bick (Tacy); Marian Everett (Caracs), all visiting Cleveport in 1966, with Maud at right. They must have had fun!

(17) Maud, Marian, and Bick in 1967. This would have been a few months after Delos died - I remember that Bick went out to stay with Maud for a while, and it seems Marian came to visit them. Nice.

(18) Outside the house in '68 or '69, I'd guess... I'm sending this one mostly for the roses!

(19) And this one mostly for the plantings around the front door.

(20) Same outfit as in (18), I think, so same year... I don't recognize the two kids... maybe Georgia will!

- (21) Maud didn't like this one of us, but it's such a great shot of her living room in the cottage in Mt. San Antonio Gardens! Again please note Brass Bowl, table, and Mr. Ray's leather chair.
- (22) Lovely shot of Maud with a little girl (could be Gene Foster's daughter Kathleen) on her patio in the Gardens.
- (23) And here she is at her desk in her bedroom in the cottage in the Gardens.
