Special Care Bond

The Trustees of Lakewood Cemetery Association, a corporation duly established under the laws of the State of Minnesota, hereby acknowledge the receipt of
. ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE AND NO/100. . . (\$175.00). Dollars
from MAUD H. LOVELACE. proprietor of
lot number 4-A in section number 45 in said cemetery,
which said sum is to be held by said corporation under the provisions of Chapter 1, Sections 3 and 5,
of its Rules and Regulations, as amended and approved March 16, 1931.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said corporation, in consideration of said payment, hereby agrees to and
with the said MAUD H. LOVELACE
her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
forever, to expend annually in special care on said lot a sum equalling the interest on said amount,
such special care to consist of Watering the Lot and such other special care
as the earnings from the fund will permit.

CHAPTER I.

Section 3. **General Care:** The general care of the entire grounds and lots (which covers maintenance of roadways, mowing grass, removing fallen leaves, etc.) is assumed by the Association; and 20% of the receipts from all lot sales are required by law to be set aside in a permanent trust, the income from which is devoted to such general care. This, however, does not provide for special care of watering lawns or vases which may be placed on lots by proprietors.
Section 5. **Perpetual Care of Lots:** Unusual outlays are from time to time rendered necessary on every lot by the impoverishment of the soil, the decay of trees or the effect of time on vaults, monuments and headstones. In order to provide for these contingencies through all time, it is advisable that each lot owner deposit a sum (in no case less than one hundred dollars [\$100.00]) with the Trustees of the Cemetery, or leave it to them by will, the principal to remain untouched, and the income only to be used upon the lot as occasion may require, so far as such income is sufficient therefor.

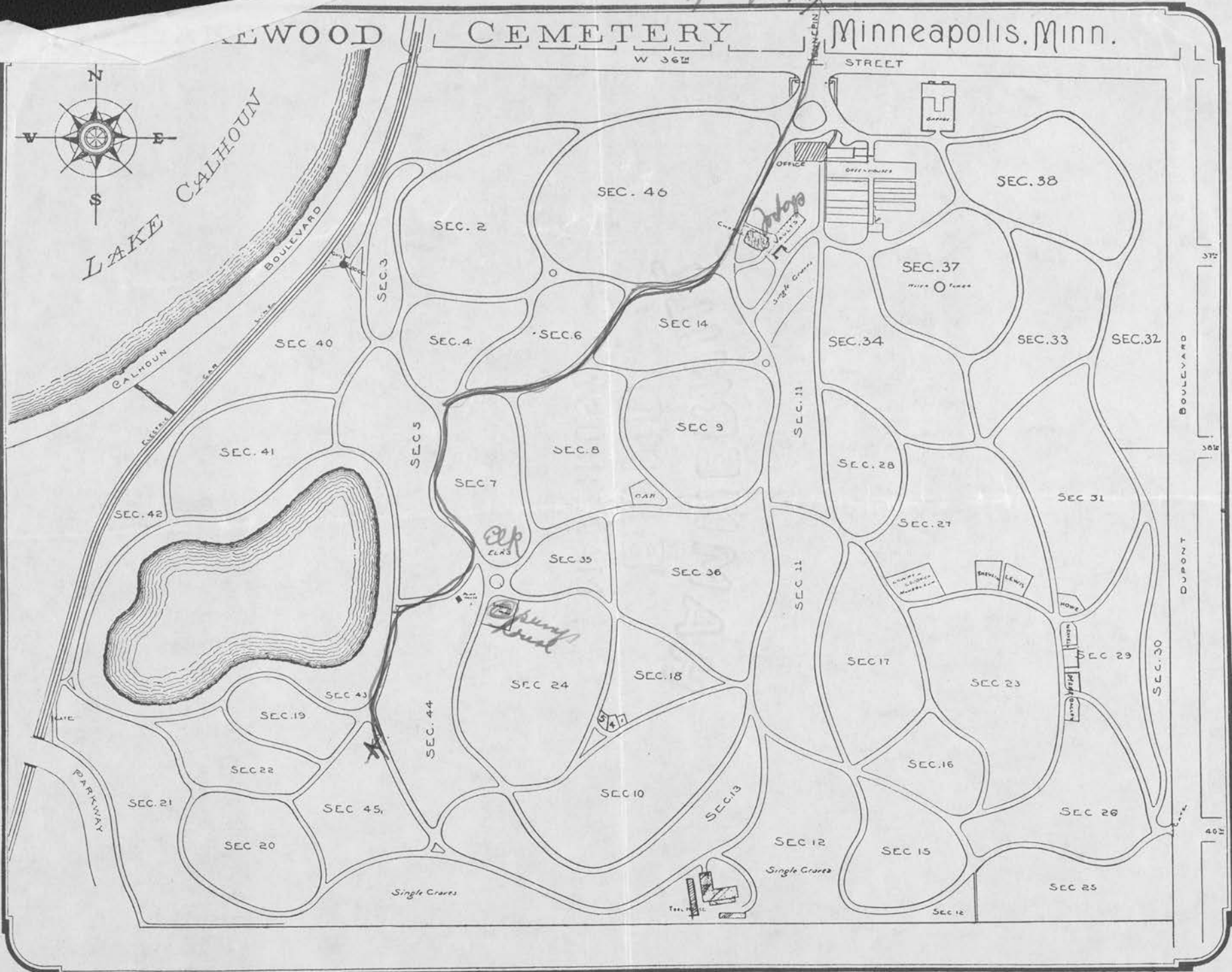

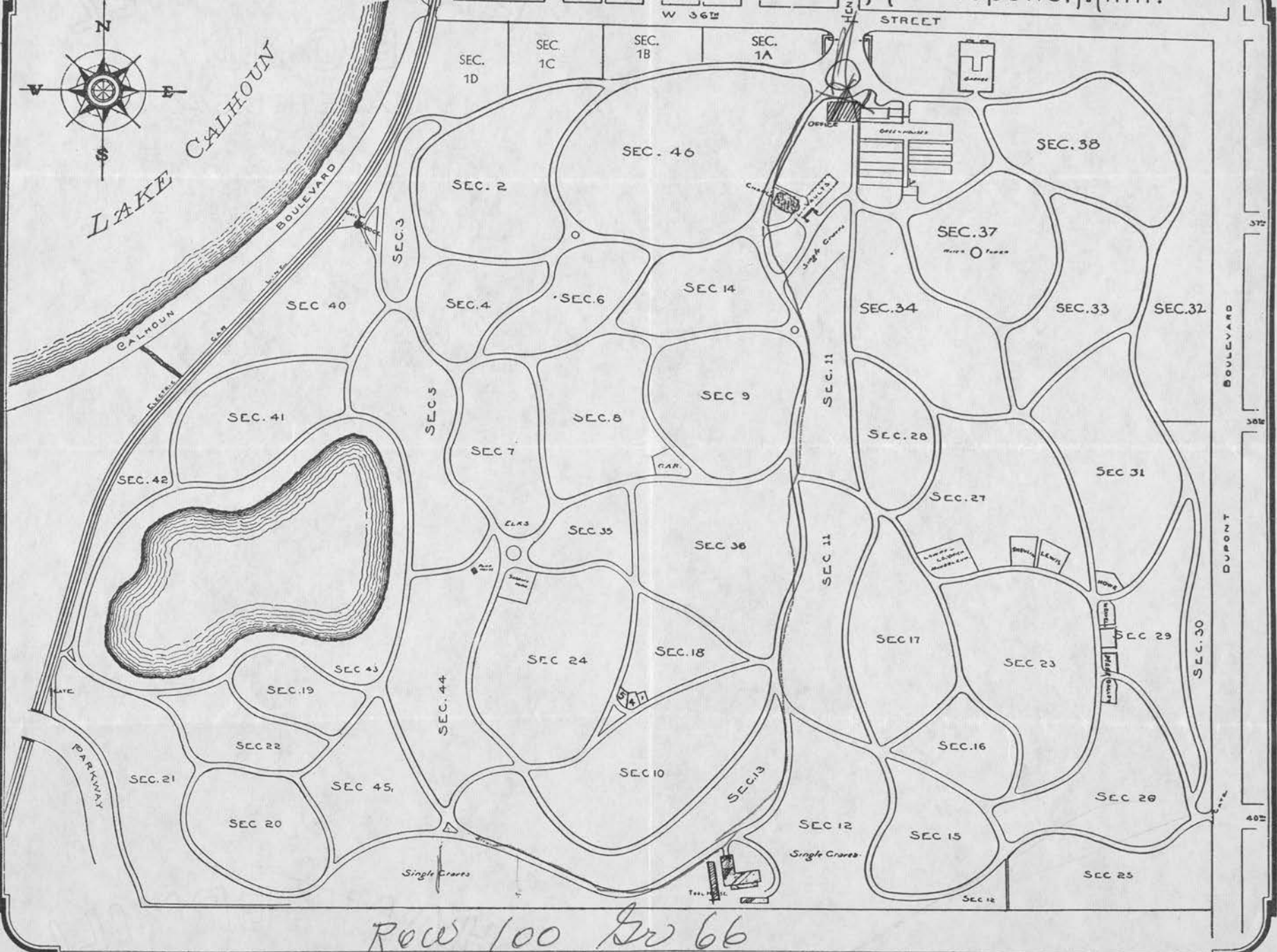
