Enclosed are applications for registration with the United States Employment Service in Minneapolis. These applications have on them the names of Nisei whose names have come to the attention of the Minneapolis War Relocation Committee through the W. R. A. lists, or through letters from individual Nisei or their relatives or friends. May we request you supervise the filling out of these applications and add any comment which will be of help in evaluation of personality, experience, skills, etc.

In the case of men, there should also be added, under "Special Information", a specific statements as to Draft Classification.

A postal card from the War Relocation Committee Desk has been sent to each of these individuals stating that the application has been sent to you and stating that "THIS IS NO GUARANTEE OF EMPLOYMENT", but that it may be an avenue to openings in their special fields.

Please return all applications. Where Nisei have left the center, please write this information across the face of the application. Where they do not wish to leave, or are not interested in resettling in Minneapolis, please give us this information also. It would help us if only those Nisei who are ready to accept offers of employment in this city fill out the applications provided the salary and field of work are satisfactory to them.

This is an experiment. It is the hope of the War Relocation Volunteer Committee and of the United States Employment Service that it will result in opening fields to highly trained and other Nisei which less accurate registration would not open to them.



Dear Mr. Merritt:

Sgt. Masuda, who is much interested in arranging for the release of Miss Chiyoko Nakasaki, has talked to me about arranging work for Miss Nakasaki. He tells me that she is working in the Center office at present, but that she would be content with domestic work for the sake of leaving the Center.

He has talked to a Lt. Coffey (navy) whose family consists of twins, eleven mos., himself and wife. They live in an upper floor apartment of six rooms. They feel their work is only part time work, so they are willing to offer thirty a month. The girl, however, is to be free to take other work by the hour among friends of Mrs Coffey in the neighborhood, and they are sure she can earn a good deal.

I should like it clearly understood that we had nothing more to do with the proposed arrangements than to send Sgt Masuda to the Coffey home. We do not approve of such an arrangement. It usually means that the work by the hour is the hardest work in the household, and the divided responsibility is apt to create difficulties.

We have very good domestic jobs here paying up to \$30.00 a month. Of course girls who have no training and experience in this work cannot command the highest salaries, but we never place at less than \$60.00 a month and would feel that one job for one family would be more desirable from the young woman's point of view.

If Miss Nakasaki wants office work we raise the question as to whether she could keep her skills up if she is not using them over some months. Usually we have suggested that they wait to come out until we have an office job open. In this case, however, there is the desire of the two young people to be together.

I am sending this data to you because we are interested in knowing the girl's attitude. So often the men make arrangements for the women which are wholly unacceptable to them once they are here. We are then accused of planning for them unwisely, and asked to remedy the situation. It is difficult to do that in some cases.

I should appreciate your report on this so that we can ask Mr White to clear with you on it provided it is what the girl wants, and you advise it.

Dear Mr. Turck:

I enclose the records of two Nisei girls who are well qualified in the field of History. I wonder if they, either one, might be usable as assistants to faculty members at Macalaster?

I shall be more than happy to cooperate in any way which would serve to bring you into contact with the girls. On the hospitality plan we have these young women come out of the Centers, stay at our homes as our guests so they may be interviewed, and find housing for them when they are ready to support themselves. You would be under no obligation to do more than state conditions of employment which would be possible if you have openings for which they qualify academically. It is understood that your acceptance of them, and theirs of the positions would depend upon the results of the interview.

If there is any way I can help these girls find employment suitably using their training and skills, I am ready to follow it. Have you suggestions?
