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The writer as administrative assistant to the Assistant Project Director was given the responsibility of organizing and setting up the Induction, Records & Statistics Bureau for the Minidoka War Relocation Project.

The functions of this department were (1) to render assistance to other Administrative divisions by maintaining up-to-date files and records pertaining to evacuees residing within the Project and those away on leave, the number of persons to be accounted for totalling approximately 10,000; (2) to make statistical surveys and studies for the Project Director and the W. R. A. office in Washington, D. C.

In setting up this department, the writer supervised census crews to obtain basic information for the files by a canvass of the project; planned the procedure for daily inflow of population data from various concerned divisions, this information being consolidated and redistributed to the heads of all departments on the Project on summary reports; and set up machinery to provide control of all egress and ingress movements of people into and out of the Project.

The writer has under his supervision at the present time 24 workers, including statistical clerks, typists, stenographers and interviewers to maintain 2 sets of population card files and an Individual Records file, as well as special files for various people coming under certain categories, ie; repatriates, parolees, etc.

The card files, one set filed alphabetically with colored cards used to denote persons on leave from the Project and the other arranged according to addresses are serviced daily to record all types of population movements into and out of the Project as well as movements within the Project itself, noting where, when and why. The Individual Records files which are maintained to correspond with the alphabetical card files, contain all records pertaining to individuals, including F. B. I. records, Internal Security reports, Social Data, Employment data, Repatriation data, and all correspondence regarding individuals in the Project. This file serves as the "Clearing House" on records of individuals seeking to leave the Project for Group Leaves or Indefinite Leaves.

From the information contained in these files, the writer has conducted statistical studies regarding various phases of population data.

The writer is also conducting a rumor bureau which collects rumors originating on the project, attempting to note the frequency,

locality and origin of these rumors. In conjunction with the rumor bureau, a "Gallup Poll" To sample the opinion of the colonists on current issues and problems is being contemplated.

Accountant in Central Food Warehouse

During the writer's stay in the Assembly Center at Puyallup, he worked in the capacity of assistant to the Food Warehouse Superintendent.

The writer was responsible for setting up the bin card system in the central warehouse, as well as the sub-warehouses, to record all food received into the warehouse and charged out to the various kitchens feeding about 7,500 persons.

Among other responsibilities was the supervision of monthly inventory of all perishable and staple foods in all the warehouses. By means of daily tabulations of food consumed as distributed by the warehouses to the kitchen, the writer assisted the steward department in determining future food requisitions.

After graduation from the University of Washington, College of Business Administration in 1936, the writer found employment in the Seattle branch office of the F. Kanematsu & Co., Ltd. of Kobe, Japan. This firm was engaged in importing and exporting business between North American and the Orient.

The writer's duties and responsibilities at first consisted of decoding cables, preparing and negotiating commercial documents, writing inter-office correspondence and assisting in transaction of business.

Subsequently, the writer was made responsible for conducting the import business of the office consisting mainly of peanuts, walnut meats to Canada from North China and Vitamin oils (tuna oil with high "A" and "D" potency) sold to various firms on the Pacific Coast. The writer also participated in the office's exporting business, specializing in purchase of wheat, hides and scrap steel for shipment to Japan. Other commodities handled by the company were casein, flour, tinplate clippings, cotton piece goods, canned tuna, and plywood.

The writer supervised keeping of data on commodities handled, volume and locality with forecasting of future business in mind.

The F. Kanematsu & Co., Ltd., closed their Seattle office in March 1941 due to darkening of international situation and growing difficulty of conducting business between United States and Japan. The writer was offered position in the company's New York office with sizeable increase in pay, however declined and remained in Seattle.


