Estimated Requirements Year 1947 "SCOTCH" Gift-Wrap and Mistlem Displays and Carded Items for Chains

MR. L. J. MONEIL

Attached to this letter are estimated requirements on "SCOTCH" Gift-Wrap Tape in diaplays and Carded Items for the year 1947 as well as Histlen displays and Carded Items for the same period.

#### GIFT\*WRAP ITEMS

These estimates are based on production over an approximate nine month period from January 1st, thru September 30th, rather than the six month period in which this material is generally produced. We plan on having printed film on hand to start production of samplesduring the first week in December in order that both our Christmas and Everyday lines will be in the hands of the salesmen on January 1, 1947. This will enable us to increase our sales considerably due to the fact that the best Everyday gift wrap season of the year runs from Valentine's Day thru Graduation. Heretofore, we have not been able to take advantage of this early everyday market.

The total number of rolls involved in the gift wrap program are 46,900,000 and we estimate that this production should be scheduled as follows:

20% during the first quarter of 1947 40% during the second quarter 40% during the third quarter

#### MISTLON

Mistlon estimates for the year 1947 have been made up based on three premises:

(1) That we will have no printed patterns in the 1947 line.

(2) That we will have printed patterns in the Christmas line only.

(3) That we will have printed patterns in both the Everyday and Christmas lines.

The maximum estimate involves 22,000,000 rolls, while the minimum involves 11,500,000 rolls. In our opinion, we will probably have printed patterns in the Christmas line only and this estimate involves 20,000,000 rolls. These estimates also are based on the premise that we will have the full line ready for presentation to our Sales Force in December to take advantage of the nine months' selling period just as we are doing on Gift-Wrap.

Production on Mistlon should be scheduled as follows:

20% during the first quarter of 1947 40% during the second quarter

40% during the third quarter

Our purpose in giving you these estimates at this date is that you might be able to discuss with the necessary parties our ability to produce this amount of material. We feel sure that from a raw material standpoint, we will be able to get the yardages involved both on Gift-Wrap and Mistlon.

However, we felt that a 70,000,000 roll Gift-Wrap and Mistlen short roll program, in addition to an approximate 120,000,000 short roll program on Transparent might prove to be a problem productionwise, especially as relates to slitting and packing. Would you please let us know at the carliost opportunity whether or not you feel these ostimates can be met and if not, just what would be involved from a standpoint of equipment etc. to enable us to meet these figures. A new sales division is being organized which will devote 100% of its time to the sale of Mistlon products. This program will be started in the following 4 branches: 1. St. Paul Mr. Fagen 2. Dallas Mr. May 3. Los Angeles -Mr. Jones 4. Buffalo Mr. Kingsley This new sales program is necessary because of changed market conditions including lower prices on satin and rayon ribbons, and widespread competition of other plastic type ribbons at lower prices. We now find it impossible to successfully compete on

a national scale under our present arrangement due to the very limited time our Cellulose Salesmen can give to Mistlon products.

## SALES ACTIVITY BY CELLULOSE GROUP

The Cellulose Division will be asked to continue selling Mistlon resale displays, both Everyday and Christmas. The allocations already made on resale items will not be changed.

All sales effort by the Cellulose Division in all branches on all other Mistlon products are to be discontinued as of June 15th. It will be necessary that you handle inquiries from present customers in your area in order that we will continue to service their requirements. Branches now stocking Mistlon may continue to do so. St. Paul will service orders for those branches who do not carry stocks.

## MISTLON ITES TO BE DISCONTINUED

Effective immediately we are discontinuing our #260 Photographic Tissue.

We are limiting our 1 ply line to 24" x 72 yard rolls only. This size will be standard in all colors and flecked patterns. We will slit no narrow rolls in 1 ply.

There will be no change in price on any Mistlon item.

No announcement is being made to the trade as to any of these changes in our program, nor are we changing our price book sheets or catalog pages because of the discontinued items. Please inform your customers of the discontinuance of the above items, but in this discussion be very careful not to leave the impression that we are curtailing our efforts on Histlen products. Make sure that they understand that we are able to take care of their requirements for Mistlon products and that they can expect service on their orders as heretofore, thru both their usual sales contacts and the branch offices.

This new program will entail a very aggressive sales campaign in the four areas mentioned, and will gradually be expanded to cover other markets as the occasion demands.

Mistlen problems which cannot be handled in the branch should be forwarded to the attention of the writer at St. Paul.

We request cooperation with the Mistlen representative working in above territories, and sincerely appreciate the effort the Cellulose Salesmen have devoted to Mistlen products.

Increased Mistlon Subject: Sales Activity.

MR. S. J. FARLEY - BUFFALO MR. H. F. GROTH - ST. PAUL MR. P. W. ROUSE - ST. LOUIS

Because of the success experienced in our experimental sales territories recently, we are immediately setting up additional sales territories on Mistlon Ribbon 100 yard lengths. This time we are setting up entire divisions as follows:

Buffalo, St. Louis, St. Paul.

We will continue the Mistlon program in the original test cities, and continue to service business elsewhere, wherever we have been enjoying some volume.

The present standard Mistlon in the 35 pound high tensile strength type is now being shipped against all orders for Mistlon Ribbon in all divisions.

We are forwarding complete sets of samples, color cards, and colored photographs to each salesman in the above divisions with the exception of those men who are already working on the Mistlon program. The samples left St. Paul November 5th and 8th: the color cards will follow on November 11th and 12th.

## SALESMEN'S TIME

No special allocation of salesmen's time should be made to Mistlon. Rather, each man should be instructed to sell Mistlon right along with our other products on his regular calls, including jobbing and all types of retail calls, where there is any possibility of the account doing some gift wrapping, either on a gratis basis, or as a charge for service.

## SALES TRAINING

In the Buffalo Division, Mr. Kingsley is already well versed on the proper Mistlon sales approach, and he will work, beginning the week of November 8th with the various men in the Buffalo Division, spending whatever length of time is necessary with each to get them properly grounded on Mistlon Ribbon.

In the St. Paul and St. Louis Divisions, Mr. Sullwold will contact the Managers a little later, regarding special training by some one of our men well versed in Mistlon techniques. However, in the meantime these men should begin to actively solicit Mistlon business. In order to give them the proper background, we are attaching to this letter 20 copies of a complete resume of Mistlon Sales information, including a Mistlon presentation which we ask that you pass on to all salesmen with your announcement of this program. It might be well to mention to the men that in the case of certain important "hard-to-get accounts" that they hold off calling on them until the time when someone who is well grounded in Mistlon works with them. However, make sure that they do not understand that this would mean reduction of the Mistlon effort on all calls. We believe that they can properly present Mistlon to small retailers, gift shops, and smaller department stores, without additional sales training, and that it might be well to hold off only on extremely important accounts.

### MISTLON SALES PROCEDURE

We call particular attention to the following items in the Mistlon general procedure set up on Price Page #152:

Note - PACKING: 12 rolls of a width and color to a shipping case. Broken carton shipments will be made from jobber's stock only.

We wish to emphasize that there are only 4 widths of Mistlon available and in 100 yards only. If, however, men receive inquiries for something other than standard, make no commitments, but refer the matter to St. Paul.

## SALES PROMOTION MATERIAL

Each salesman will be provided with full 100 yard sample rolls of each color in a variety of widths. Color Cards of Mistlon Ribbon will be made up for jobbers salesmen's use, with a sample of each color and width on the card.

Printed Price Sheets showing jobber and consumer prices are being prepared, and a quantity will be sent to each. A few are attached to this letter.

Glossy photographs of packages decorated with Mistlon are being furnished to each salesman.

## JOBBING OUTLETS

Paper Jobbers, principally.

### DELIVERY DATES

We will accept orders for 15-day shipment from St. Paul, and attempt to ship earlier whenever possible. Advance orders may be taken for later shipment at customer's request.

#### NO BRANCH STOCKS

We will ship direct to jobbers and/or consumers from St. Paul and charge jobbers. We do not plan any branch stocks until further notice.

We are attaching a few price book pages and a small supply of catalog pages, both consumer and jobber types, to this letter. We ask that you forward these to the men in your division as you announce the initiation of this program. Larger supplies of all these items are being sent to your branch marked to your attention and more can be obtained from St. Paul upon your request.

### MISTLON PRESENTATION

We believe that all salesmen concerned with the promotion of Mistlon will benefit by studying the selling aids sent in to us by Messrs. Curley in Minneapolis, Poole in Fort worth, and May in Dallas. These men have enjoyed considerable success in the sale of Mistlon. We believe that the following material answers the question - "How do they do it?"

We would like to break this selling ammunition down into four phases - and review them singly:

- I. Markets.
- II. Demonstration Techniques.
- III. Price Comparisons.
- IV. Suggested Presentation.
  - 1. When working alone.
  - 2. When working with jobbers' salesmen.

### I. MARKETS

We think it would be of interest to all concerned to know what type of accounts use the greatest percentage of all types of Ribbons for Gift Wrapping. The following is a break-down percentagewise:

Gift Stores	25%
Dept. Stores	20%
Independent Jewslers	15%
Men's Stores	10%
Chain Jewelers	10%
Ladies' Stores	15%
Drug Stores	5%
TOTAL	100%

#### II. DEMONSTRATION TECHNIQUES

In order to present Mistlon properly, you must be able to tie a bow, and at the same time demonstrate, in the way of service, new gift wrap techniques which can be picked up from any good gift-wrap department - for example:

- (a) Learn how to make roses out of Mistlon Ribbon.
- (b) Learn how to make some of the following bows before making a call with Mistlon Ribbon:

The figure eight, criss-cross rosette, the floral bow, the pom-pom bow, the pin wheel bow, and the tailored bow.

## II. DEMONSTRATION TECHNIQUES (Cont'd.)

We recommend using the pom-pom bow because it is the easiest to tie and shows Mistlon to the greatest advantage.

We suggest you carry a box already wrapped with ribbons that apply to the season, for example: Silver Flecked Ribbon for Christmas season, Pastel colors for Everyday, Brown for men's stores, etc.

### III. PRICE COMPARISONS

The following table shows a comparison from the standpoint of using Mistlon versus the ribbons mentioned below in tying gift packages of various standard sizes. The width of the ribbon used, the number of yards used per package, and the cost of the ribbon involved in each case was carefully worked out with a leading St. Paul Department Store; and as far as the width and quantities used are concerned, these figures are from their standard table which guides each of their girls at the wrapping desk.

You will notice that Mistlon Ribbon compares extremely favorably as against Satin, and that on boxes up to and including 13 x 9 x 1-1/8, it is actually somewhat cheaper to use Mistlon than Ribbonzene or Ribbonette for fancy wrapping due to the shorter yardage of Mistlon necessary to create a pleasing package.

We believe that the following table is self-explanatory, and that it can be used to a great advantage in presenting Mistlon Ribbon in department stores, ladies' ready-to-wear shops, etc.

## INTRODUCTION:

"My name is John Smith - we sell "SCOTCH" TAFE to you folks. We have a brand new idea for your gift wrapping department that we believe will save you time and money and bring more customers into your store. We want to show it to you.

"This is our new product, MISTION - isn't it beautiful? It's a non-woven textile, made from cellulose-acetate fibre and viscose rayon. The fibres are very similar to those used in the manufacture of Nylon hose."

## I. TELL 'EM ABOUT IT'

"This meterial is made especially for gift-wrapping.

"Before marketing it on a nation-wide basis, we tested customer acceptance in five areas - New York, Dallas, Los Angeles, Buffalo, and Chicago - in such stores as Bonwit Tiller, Altmans, Mardel Bros., and many others; and these tests proved to us without question that there is a definite need in the gift-wrapping field for a moderately priced ribbon. We sincerely believe that we have such a ribbon in our MISTLON."

"These stores all told us - and, incidentally, they are using MISTLON today -

- (ACCEPTANCE) 1. that Gift Wrap customers prefer our ribbon because of its misty, new, different appearance.
- (WORKABILITY) 2. that the girls in their gift wrapping departments find it much easier to work with than other ribbons.
- (PRICE) 3. that MISTLON substantially reduces their gift wrapping costs.
- "I'm not much of a gift-wrapper myself as a matter of fact, (I still can't tie, or I couldn't tie a Windsor Knot in my tie until about a year ago, as the case may be) but I would like to pass on to the girls in your gift wrapping department a couple of ideas that we've picked up around the country in other gift-wrapping departments like your own. At the same time, I would like to have them work with MISTLON themselves I mean tie a couple bows, etc. FAIR ENOUGH?"

#### II. DEMONSTRATE TO THE GIRLS

Show them the bows - and ask them to try it themselves - show them the "Stork Idea" with a safety pin, and how to make a carnation out of a piece of Kleenex. Point out during the demonstration that:

- 1. MISTLON will conform to any given place on a bow.
- 2. MISTLON has no spring, such as satin ribbon has MISTLON is soft and flexible.
- 3. MISTLON makes up into full rounded bows or tailored bows.
- 4. MISTLON is moisture-resistant MISTLON will not wilt.

## III. DISCUSS PRICE

- 1. MISTLON is a moderately priced gift wrapping medium 1/3 the cost of Satin; slightly higher than comparable widths of the Chicago Printed String type.
- 2. MISTION prices are stable, where other prices fluctuate.





There will be no increase in prices of Mistlen display items for resale. New flocked patterns are being added to the line. They are those for which we have had continued demand both from our salesmen and customors. PRICE INCREASE EFFECTIVE MONDAY MORNING, MARCH 3 The effective date of this price increase is March 3. All orders in the house shipped on or after March 3, will be billed at the new prices. 2 ply orders dated March 3 or before will be shipped and billed at our present 2 ply prices. No new orders for 2 ply material will be accepted dated later than March 3. BRANCIES TO NOTIFY THE TRADE OF THE PRICE CHANGE We do not as yet have an accurate list of Mistlon jobbers and dealers in St. Paul. florufore, we are asking each branch to notify those accounts who are active on listlen Products of this price change and to also distribute new cost sheets and catalog pages to them. PRICE BOOK PAGE #150 - MISTLON PLASTIC RIBBON IN DISPLAY BOXES EVERYDAY AND CHRISTMAS ASSORTMENTS -

Mistlon displays, both Everyday and Christmas assortments, will be offered in 1947 on an allocation basis. The allocation for each branch will be announced on both Christmas and Everyday displays within the next 30 days.

Everyday Displays #200 and #201 will be available approximately April 15. Christmas Displays #202 and #203 will be available approximately May 15.

The Christmas assortment has been changed to include silver flecked patterns on white and colored backgrounds as we found them to be highly desirable in test displays last year.

Our Christmas display boxes will carry the same artwork as last year but the colors will be tened up to give a much brighter and more colorful effect.

Carded items for the Chains will not be available at present either in Everyday or Christmas patterns.

There is no change in price nor in discount schedules on the above display items.

## PRICE BOOK HA GE #151 - CAT. #260 - MISTLON PHOTOGRAPHIC TISSUE -

The price on Mistlon Photographic Tissue (24" x 6 yard roll white only) has been increased from \$1.98 to \$2.50 - an increase of 26%.

- (1) 576 rolls will entitle the customer to the maximum 35% discount. This should greatly increase the number of customers qualifying for maximum discounts.
- (2) Jobbers now receive 35% discount instead of 34% on orders for stock.
- (3) Jobber discounts on direct to consumer shipments have been changed as follows:

  144 rolls or more (1" equivalent) to be shipped direct and billed to
  Jobbers on written orders from Jobbers at the following discounts:

  144 rolls 50-12%

576 rolls or more = 35-723

The greatest number of drop shipped orders to date have fallon in the 144 roll discount bracket. Here we are offering the jobbers an additional 2%. On 576 roll orders for 2g ply ribbon, 1" x 72 yard or equivalent, the invoice value is \$599.04. On this invoice, the jobber margin is 7.5%, a reduction from our former 10% discount. However, the jobber's refit margin on the above invoice value is \$44.92 which we believe our jobbers will agree is an equitable profit margin when they are not handling material out of stock and are merely performing an ordering and billing service for their customer.

Stationer and jobber discounts are identical, yet the jobber can sell the stationer small quantities of distlon in 72 yard rolls at a profit of 13.3%.

## T.PORTATT - CHANGE IN E. UIVALENT AND ASSORTING PRIVIL GE

1" EQUIVALENT PRIVILEGE: Applies to all trade classes. Rolls wider than 1" may be converted to the 1" equivalent to make quantity. Example: 18 rolls 2" x 72 yards takes the 36 roll discount. 6 rolls 24" x 72 yards takes the 144 roll discount.

This equivalent privilege does away with the inequities with which we formerly penalized customers who purchased wide width material. Under this equivalent privilege, which applies to all trade classes, an invoice value of a certain number of dollars takes the same quantity discount whether the customer buys 24" or 1/2" material or a combination of many widths. We believe that this particular change will be warmly velcomed by the trade.

ASS WITH THE 72 yard rolls may be assorted to make quantity in may ply, width, color or flecked pattern. We assorting with any other items.

This privilege allows those customers who are interested in both 1 and 25 ply to combine both plys for quantity in any assortment of colors and widths. By combining the two types, the customer is able to make maximum quantity at a lower invoice value than heretofore was possible. This change also should be well received by the trade.







Curtailment of Sales Effort on Histlen Products

ALL CELLULOSE TAPE SALESMENS

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During the past three months, we have experienced an increase in sales of all Mistlon Products far beyond our normal expectations. We have a large expansion program in progress on Mistlon production, but the difficulties being encountered in obtaining new equipment are delaying the completion of this program by more than six months. Our present sales come close to equaling our present production capacity. Therefore, it is necessary to curtail sales activity on Mistlon products until further notice.

# MISTLON LIERS DISCONTINUED

In order to obtain maximum production on our best items, we are discontinuing the following items in the Mistlon line:

- (1) Discontinue all sheet goods in all plys Price Book Pages #158 and #159
- (2) Discontinue the following fleck patterns on rolls 4" and wider Price Book Page #156.

(3) Discontinue all special colors and special flected patterns on all items. Please make these corrections on Price Book Pages 155 and 156.

# MISTION TIME STILL AVAILABLE

we will continue to sell the following items:

Histlen Ribbon Displays - Page #151 (on allocation)
Histlen Carded Items - Page #152 and #153.

Please make all necessary changes on your price book pages to keep thom up to date.

# ORDERS ON FILE FOR DISCONTINUED ITEMS

All orders for discontinued Mistlen items now in the branches or in St. Paul will be shipped approximately 45 days from date of receipt in St. Paul. Now orders for discontinued Mistlen items dated October 14 or later, will be returned to the branches for substitution or cancellation.

# CURTAILMENT OF SALES EFFORT

It is not our intent that all sales activity on Mistlen be discontinued but that our efforts be channeled in directions which will produce the maximum of lasting business when shortages of competitive materials no longer exist. We suggest that sales activity be directed as follows:

# INDUSTRIAL ACTIVITY

- 1. Continue working with accounts already contacted on Mistlon in the direction of functional uses where our product does a better job than competitive products rather than acting as a substitute for scarce items.
- 2. Discontinue new industrial contacts almost entirely except where new applications rather than substitutions are apparent. Our limited production for the next few months makes it necessary that we service only those accounts in which we can see possibilities of steady future volume when shortages no longer existo

# JOBBER-REPAIL ACTIVITY

- 1. Displays, both Christmas and Everyday, will continue on an allocation lasis and whatever minimum activity is necessary to sell these quantities is in order.
- 2. 72 Yard Ribbon and Roll Goods will still be produced in good quantity but we suggest that work be done only on accounts already contacted on Mistlen; not only those accounts already sold but also continue working with those where considerable ground work has been laid. No new accounts should be worked for the time being. We do not believe that it will be necessary to to 8n an allocation basis on 72 yard Histlen Ribbon or Roll Goods if the above suggestions are followeds

# CURTAILMENT OF JOBBER SALES EFFORT

Please make certain that your jobbers, both those calling on the retail trade and those calling on industrial accounts are notified of the changes in the line and the necessary curtailment of sales activity. We must be sure that they understand clearly our present production situation and the type of business which we prefer to accept during this "limited sales" period. If jobber activity were to continue unchecked and we are unable to deliver listlen within a reasonable period, we could cause much hard feeling among our good "SCOTCA" Cellulose Tape Jobbers.

# DEADLINE ON TAKING CURISTMAS BUSINESS

Effective October 15th, we will be unable to accept any additional orders for Mistlon for shipment by December 1st. Most of our present backlog on orders must be shipped early enough for use in December and we cannot promise shipment on orders taken after October 15th, until the last half of December which we feel is too late for consumption before the holidays.

We regret the necessity of curtailing Mistlon activity at this time but feel that it is wiser to follow this course than to go on accepting increased volume to the point where we would be unable to service those good accounts already established.

As soon as our production outlook improves, you will be notified and sales activity can again be expanded.






