Known all men by these presents that J. John Guggemus of Waconia Carver County Minnesota are held <sup>and</sup> firmly bound unto Emerentia Guggemus of the same place in the sum of Forty Five hundred dollars for which payment well <sup>and</sup> truly to be made bind my heirs, executors administrators <sup>and</sup> assigns firmly by these presents.

Sealed with my seal <sup>and</sup> dated this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1896.

Whereas - the said Emerentia Guggemus widow of Charles Guggemus late of Carver County Minnesota has this day by Quit Claim Deed conveyed unto the said John Guggemus all her right <sup>and</sup> dower in the following described lands to wit: The South West quarter of Section Twenty Seven 27, Township one hundred <sup>and</sup> sixteen 116, of Range Twenty Five (25) West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian Minnesota, subject however to the following Articles of agreement to wit:

Article "1. The said Emerentia Guggemus to be entitled during her natural <sup>(life)</sup> to the two rooms west end of building as now occupied by her, <sup>(in)</sup> and in case of her death said rooms to be reserved for Anna Guggemus, provided, however said rooms only reserved to her alone, and only when she has <sup>(now)</sup> ~~not~~ other home, sick <sup>and</sup> in need.

medical aid in time of sickness and a christian  
burial at time of death, also to pay to said Emerentia  
Guggemos at such time and in such amounts as  
she demands during her life time the sum of



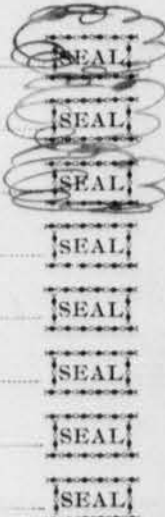
