I give, devise, bequeath my estate and property, real and personal,

as follows, that is to say:

50.33 acres in West Half of the North-east quarter Sec. 1 Two 114-Range 24

10 acres in East-half of the North-east quarter Sec. 12-Twp 114-Range 24

15 acres in West-half of the South-east quarter Sec. 36-Twp 115-Range 24

39.75 acres in South-west & of South-east & Sec.36-Twp 115-Range 24 All said described land located in the Township of San Francisco, County of Carver and State of Minnesota, U.S.A.

Out of the proceeds of the above described real-estate I will to my son Erland Lindquist of Turtle Lake N. Dak the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) as payment for his keeping me and taking care of me until I die. Also all funeral expenses and arrangements necessary to bury my body and ship it shall be taken out of the proceeds of said above described real-estate.

When the above \$1500.00 has been paid to my son Erland Lindquist and said funeral expenses has been all paid then the balance I will


