His Excellency
Gov. Ramsey.
Sir.

I have rec'd notice that 3 boxes of Arms belonging to the State are in the hands of Leinple & Caspary, warehousemen, on which are \$1.50 charges, & 8 boxes of State Arms, in possession of Parbuck & Co., on which the charges are \$1.00. These arms are returned to the State from disbanded military companies. I have to request, inasmuch as I have the control of no fund for that purpose, that you will furnish the means of paying the aforesaid charges and bringing the arms to the Capitol.
