M^r. Alexander Ramsey,
Governor of the State of Minnesota,

St. Paul,

After there was given me a full assurance
that the Land of which I was already
in possession for the time of 6 years,
and where I had in the first years,
many misfortunes, by unexpected and
unforeseen calamities, came back so
far, that it was impossible for me
to pay, request by the United States
Government, I resolved, as far as it is
acceptable, to offer to the Government
my services,

I served previously in the Cavalry
in Prussia for ten years as a sub-
altern officer in good standing, as
you Excellency may see from the
enclosed certificate, and served also
in some particular circumstances
as a Quarter-master pro tem and
attended Watch-Masters services,

Therefore I wish to be excused to
address myself to offer to you these
and perhaps other service, you may
find me fit to perform. I would
further remark that I am one fifty years
of age and that I am not able to
speak the English Language sufficient-
ly, and therefore ask if this want
would be an abstacle to employ
me in any good German Cavalry Regi-
ment. Further more, I would remark
that I feel ~~my~~ myself able bodied
enough to satisfy a trust in such an
employment, and hope my practical
military experience will meet the
satisfaction of my superiors.

the drill, as practiced in the drill-

a position as Captain, in my native State (Penn.);
but prefer to cast in my lot with my friends
in the state of my adoption,

Should you appoint me to the po-
sition indicated, I shall spare no pains
in qualifying myself for the proper dis-
charge of its duties; and I would re-
ceive such a mark of your confidence
as a favor not soon to be forgotten.
