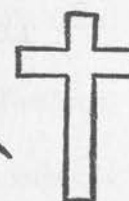

PREFACE

It is equally important that the business man should know what services to expect of a bank, what he must do to obtain the greatest possible benefit from his

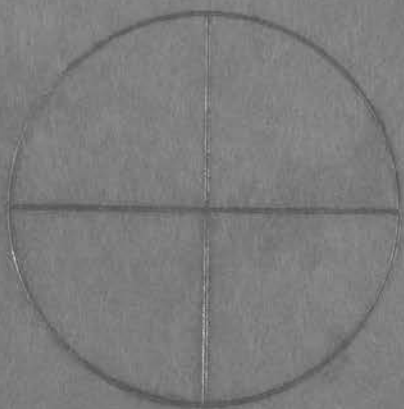
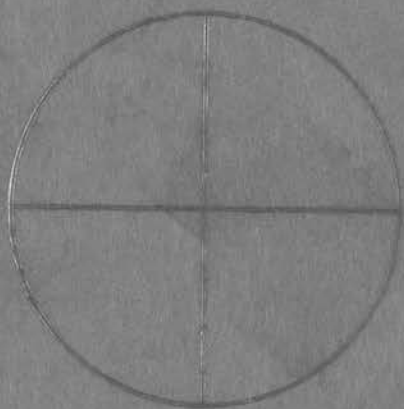
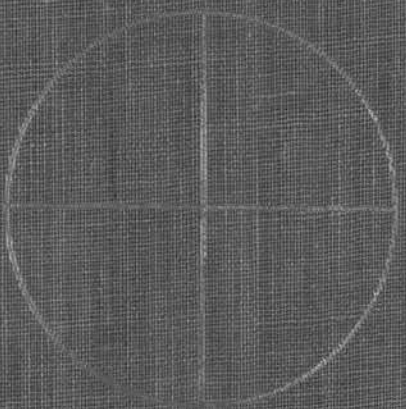
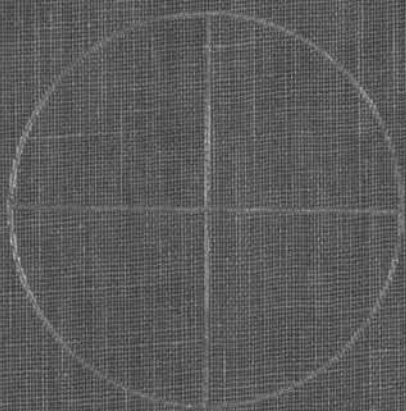
