PREFACE

Banking concerns every business man intimately, not only in the everyday affairs of his business but also in matters of public interest. He needs to understand his country's banking system so that he may express an intelligent opinion upon the subject when called upon to do so by his friends or at the polls, and so that he may realize how his own business may be affected by changes in the system or in the method of its operation.

For that reason considerable emphasis has been placed on the development of banking through its 2,500 years of evolution.
