80 acres ($W_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ Sec 25) was bought from the railroad. While the farm has not been in the family for quite 100 years, it was deeded to the Railroad 100 years ago, and the Mutsch family was the first owner starting in 1883 and has been continous ownership since. The Mutschs also originally purchased the adjoining 80 acres ($N_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $NW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ Sec. 36) in 1884 from the state, but sold it in 1900. It is now owned by Harold J. Wolle and is part of the family farm. The $E_2^{\frac{1}{2}}$ of $SW_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ Sec 25 was purchased in 1889, and has been continuous family ownership since that time.

The fifth generation, my son, Harold John Wolle, Junior, is now also farming this land.
