Answer No. 5 - He came to America June 19, 1869 together with his wife. They stayed with a friend of theirs from Sweden who had already settled in this community. In 1876 his wife died, leaving him with 3 children ranging in age from 3 to 7 years. He lived until he was 82 years making his home with his son Charlis who had bought the home farm.
