He landed in Canada and sailed the speat Lakes, for a time, He landed in miluarker, Wis. He lived for a while in Dane Co. Wisconsin. Ite took "squatters rights" in Blue Earth Co. Mm. Mot liking it there because of the "sticky gumbo soil," Later took a homistiad in Dakota Co, Mm. Critical of sandy soil "there.

"While here he was showing horses for soldiers who had just returned from an indian uprising in northwestern of mn. From them, he learned of the 'Alenwood country" He thin walked with his dog and gun, to this area, He liked what, he saw and went to St Cloud to buy 40 acres by white Bear Lake, (now John Minnewaska) Later added acresse to 320. Some of the lakeshow has been sold. 290 acres remain. The first lived in a but until he built a 24×24/t log eatin, which still stands today, He then went book to Dane Co. Wis and berought his bride back to the new home. They raised 7 sons and one daughter. My father Henry, and his brother, Theodore, bought the farm in 1917, and operated as Halvarson Bros. Farm, Theodox never married. He sold his share to Henry in 1945. Henry in tyrnsold it to me, norman, his son, in 1959. I have 3 sons and one daughter and hope to turn The farm over to one or all, in time. There have actually been five generations on this farm as my great grandfather, Halvor A., came over in 1873. He was born in 1799, just 23 years after the revolution. He died here in 1889,
