The Cole farm, has been in the family for three generations. Having been homesteaded by his Grandfather, Lewis Larson, who later changed his name to Lars Cole. According to the Homestead act of 1862, it was necessary to live on, and improve the land for 5 years. Virgil Cole's Grandfather, having met the necessary requirements, was given title to the land by the United States General Land Office, the 9th of April, 1881. The land has been lived on Continuosly, by members of the family for 100 years. The farm is now being operated by Virgil Cole, third generation, and prior to that by his father, Albert Cole, who was born, raised, and lived his entire life on the farm.
