In 1930 the two older sons of Jac.K. Rupperected what is one of the first water retention dams in the area on the south 80 using horses and slip scrapers. Many local youngsters learned to swim in "Rupp's Dam".

We are proud of our heritage at the courage of these forebears who struck out for an unknown land, carved out a farm, a home and a church for themselves and their children. Both sets of Russell's grandparents are buried in a small cemetery a mile to the north, as well as his parents and various other relatives. This spot was once their Mennonite church grounds.
