I ame time later abour moved to a homestead near the present town of Granada, just east of Fairmont. The town was called Handy for awhile The railroad came through and the R.R. said there was another town by the name of Handy and the freight was getting mind up - so it was changed to Granada. Then nor since did we ever find a town by the name of Handy in minn. abner wanted charles to go to school. He went to winnehogo to school that town is about "4 miles n. E. of Glanda. He boarded and roomed with Ber, John Crapsey. That is how charles met his lovely wife alice Crapsey. Some time later charles came to this area to look for a homestead. He found one near the town of Kimbrae, minn. For some unknown reason he had an uncie, Deorge tanner, who was supposed to file a claim for charles. Leonge

liked the spat so he filed the Claim in his own name never again did charles ever about the same time the crapery filed a claim just north of us charles came in 1868 and filed a claim on the east shore of talcots Those days money was seares, so they traded most everything charles had a team of open at first - he broke 10 acres of sod for the Trapseye, His pay was a 2 ig. old steer. For Hyears that had to drive to Jackson for grocery + supples-ammunition, the soldiere were there at the stockade. It could shoot the Indians, in hen the grase thoppers were bad, the people went farther away to plow and busk corn for 26 a month. They had to get up early in the morning to shoot the blackbirds to key them out of the Corn as there was only 4 fields of corn in the whole They had in a dug out for awhile There was must have been some dug out there was troom for a set of square dancing heades the household items. Charles brother Don -played the violin. all 3 of charles sons played violins but charles couldn't play a note

. Charles had two brothers that homesteaded Close by milton to the north end of lalcott Lake and Don 4 miles to the south east en Jackson Co. These brothers took turns going to Granada to see to their elder farents They would go to Jackson + carny near the fort for the night and on to Granada the nit waythis was before we had railroads or telephone or even layed out roads. Charles and Don had a timber claim in Oregon they raised cattle on the upper slope They cut hay on the lower slapes - carried the hay to the cattle From this timber claim they cut down trees for lumber. I key had a brother martin in north hakota who had a sow mill. Some how they got the saw mill to Oregon and sawed 3 carloade of lumber and shipped it to Granada . That summer charles and Loncame to Granada and built ce new barn on the old homstead. They were excellent carpentars The barn stell stands don did most of the cooking - was real clean about it all Perhaps be had to help his mother as she had no girle. Later charles and son took their elderly parents to Oregon - cared for them and buried them there,

The Handy raised mostly beef. In the wenter they would butcher their beefin real cold weather - freeze the carcuse - ties them to a seed and take them to mankato to sell on the open market In 1925 my parents moved close to Shaneda so I could go to Granada school It was a grader 1-12 home er department manuel training for boys science lab library a gym- was heated by steam boiler LE. Handy was fanitar for 26 yr. Hes son chester event to school there, He and I were in the graduating class of 1931 It was during the depression - heit & went to teacher training and taught rural school for seven up. Of Henrytown Answers Last Call. A Resident of Fillmore County Since 1853. Seventy-Eight Years Old.

M. H. Onstine of Henrytown died Saturday evening after an illness of nearly a month. Services from the house and the Henrytown church were held Tuesday and the remains were consigned to rest in the near-by Richland Cemetery, Rev. Jones of Canton and Rev. Bailey of Kasota officiating. Honorary pall bearers were selected from the Old Settlers, Soldiers and Sailors Association of which organization he had long been Secretary.

Deceased was an exemplary citizen, a kind husband and father, and was active in public affairs during the early history of the county. The following interesting biographical sketch of this old pioneer is taken from the Fillmore County

History:

Michael H. Onstine was born in Loraine County, Ohio, in August, 1835. His father, having a taste for adventure, spent most of his time in traveling and when Michael was eight years old the two went on a trip to Pennyalyania the form was eight years old the two went on a trip to Pennyslvania, the former home of the family. In 1847 they crossed the prairie to Galena, Ill., and took a trip on the steamer "Highland Mary" to Fort Snelling. While they were at the Falls of St. Anthony the boat left them and they crossed the land to St. Paul, where they stopped at Hotel Bass, the first hotel in that city. The "Ben Franklin" was at that time engaged in moving some Winnebagoes and Sioux to the Crow Wing reservation. About four thousand were camped at St. Paul and around Fort Snelling. A small frame were camped at St. Paul and around Fort Snelling. A small frame house and a lone soldier to guard the Indians was all that the Onstines saw on the Minneapolis side. The Onstines boarded the 'Ben Franklin' and descended the river as far as the mouth of the Chippewa, where they joined a crew of faftsmen, and labored at the sweeps for seven days before reaching the for seven days before reaching the ferry opposite Galena. In August, 1853, Michael H. Onstine came with the Onstine party to Amherst ownship, where he has since reided.

In 1858 he married Augusta Osood, one of the early school teachers in the county, daughter of John osgood, one of the first settlers in ortheastern Iowa. Mrs. Onstine died Jan. 9, 1906, leaving three ons: Elbert, Frank and Elmer.

nother son Henry, died in 1864, t the age of two years. 1n 1858 Mr. Onstine was elected he first town clerk of Amherst. e served as postmaster under three dministrations, has held many ther officers of trust and has always en a leader in public affairs.
