

John W. and Sabrina Betts were living here at this time as their first child was born here in 1881.
On the Abstract of Title, it can be noted the land was mortgaged for \$ 450 at 10% interest as John W. Betts did not have the entire \$ 560 which was the purchase price, or \$ 7.00 per acre.
Land prices were on the rise, as by 1896, John W. Betts purchased an adjoining 40 acres for \$ 1000, or \$ 25.00 per acre. Interest rate at

of the national interests and general welfare of his community. Whatever tends to benefit town and county receives his hearty support and co-operation, and the community recognizes him as a citizen that it could ill afford to lose. In manner he is pleasant and genial, always courteous and affable, and withal a true gentleman in the best sense of that term.

UDOLPH JAGODZINSKE, Welcome, Minnesota, is one of the thrifty Germans who has acquired a nice property and comfortable home in Martin county.

He was born in Margouin, Posen, Germany, April 8, 1850, son of Martin and Henrietta (Dumke) Jagodzinske In 1868 Martin Jagodzinske emigrated with his family to America, settled in Green Lake county, Wisconsin, where he worked at his trade, that of shoemaker, for several years, and from there removed to Fond du Lac. Wisconsin. At Fond du Lac he served as watchman, employed by a Mr. Meyers, occupying this position until his death. He was born November 2, 1819, and died November 16, 1874, and was about fifty-five years of age at the time he died. His first wife, nee Henrietta Dumke, was born February 1, 1820, and died during the last part of September, 1853, when her son and only child, Rudolph, was three years old. January 18, 1854, he married, for his second wife, Amalia Frederick, who was born October 2, 1832, and is still living. By this marriage there were the following children: Ferdinand, Matilda, Flora, William, Hattie, Louis and Minnie.

Rudolph Jagodzinske came with the family to this country, and almost immediately

after his arrival here he started out in life on his own responsibility. For three years he worked for James Densmore, of Green Lake county, Wisconsin. It was the father's wish that his son should learn the trade of shoemaker, but knowing in what poverty his people had always been kept by following this calling, our subject brought all his influence to bear on his father, and finally induced him to give up the trade and go to Fond du Lac, as stated above. Young Rudolph was robust and exceptionally strong, and hence took to farm work. In June, 1871, he came to Minnesota and in Faribault county worked at whatever he could get to do. He also visited Martin county, in September of that year, in company with his future father-in-law, Friedrich Wilhelm Mr. Bursack located a quarter Bursack. section in Fraser township, and Mr. Jagodzinske located an eighty-acre tract, the south half of the southwest quarter of section 24, Fox Lake township. After this they returned to Wisconsin, and during the same fall of 1871 the entire family drove through to their new homes, our subject having in the meantime married Miss Paulina Bursack. The little house to which he took his bride is now used as a poultry house, his present fine residence having been built in 1887. He built his barn in 1891. In 1879 he bought an additional eighty acres of the railroad company,—the north half of the northwest quarter of section 25, Fox Lake township; and in 1885 he bought still another eighty,—the south half of the southeast quarter of section 24, Fox Lake township. He again added to his possessions in the fall of 1894, by purchasing the southeast quarter of section 15, Fox Lake township. With the exception of one acre, which he gave to the Evangelical Church in

1891, he still owns all this land, 200 acres being under cultivation, three and a half acres in woodland, and the rest used as hay and pasture land. The stock on his farm at this writing consists of sixty hogs, fifty cattle and ten horses.

Mr. Jagodzinske was married September 28, 1871, to Paulina Bursack, who was born in Wisconsin, March 15, 1852, the second of the seven children of William and Henriette (Plath) Bursack. Mr. Bursack was born in Posen, Germany, March 6, 1823, and died May 18, 1885. Mrs. Caroline Henriette (Plath) Bursack was born October 31, 1826, in Posen, Germany, and died September 20, 1864, in Green Lake county, Wisconsin. Mr. Bursack emigrated to America in 1851, settled in Wisconsin, and lived there until his removal to Martin county, where he died.

The children of Mr. and Mrs. Jagodzinske are as follows: Emma Adelia Alvina, born June 17, 1872, was married to George Rushmann, December 12, 1894, and is living on a farm in Jackson county, Minnesota; Rosa Henrietta, born July 5, 1874, was married September 9, 1894, to John Galles, a farmer of Martin county; Amelia Henrietta, born March 22, 1876; Julius Ferdinand, born February 25, 1878; Luella Viola, born September 9, 1880, died June 11, 1882; Aaron Benjamin, born August 11, 1882; George Benjamin Harrison, born December 23, 1888, died April 12, 1892; and Frederick William Herrman, born September 20, 1890.

Mr. Jagodzinske is a man of excellent judgment and business ability. For fourteen consecutive years he has served as Appraiser, and is generally regarded as the best officer in this capacity the township has ever had. He and his family are members of the Evangelical church.

B. HERBRANDSON came to Jackson county in 1869, and is the present Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of Petersburg township. He is a native of Norway, born March 22, 1844, and a son of Benson and Barabra (Tulletson) Herbrandson, who were the parents of seven children, five of whom are now living: H. B., the subject; Tulleff, a farmer residing in Dickinson county, Iowa; Lars, still residing in the old country; Ingree, wife of Ole Munn; and Jacob, now living in Dickinson county, Iowa. An uncle, Evan Herbrandson, also came to this country and has been a resident of Petersburg township, Jackson county, for more than thirty years.

The gentleman whose name heads this record acquired his education in the common schools of his native land, was confirmed in the Norwegian Lutheran Church and was reared on the old home farm. April, 1867, he bade adieu to home and friends, for he had resolved to try his fortune in America, and sailed from Bergen on a three-masted sailing vessel, -the Claus Heftie,-which after forty days spent on the bosom of the Atlantic dropped anchor in the harbor of Quebec. From that place Mr. Herbrandson made his way to Mitchell county, Iowa, where he began work as a farm hand and spent two years.

While in that county he was united in marriage with Miss Barabra Torsen, who was born in Norway on the 22d of February, 1844. She had come to America on the same vessel with her future husband, whom she had known in the old country, and their wedding was celebrated May 20, 1869, in the Norwegian Lutheran Church, by Rev. C. Clausen. The young couple soon came to Minnesota and Mr. Herbrandson secured from the Government 160 acres of wild land



ADDITIONAL COMMENTS: In 1871 Henry Ledebur came to the U.S. at age of 14 yrs. He left his home in Bremen, Germany and came to LaCrosse, Wisc. with relatives. He lived with them 2 yrs, and then moved to Wykoff, Mn. where he met his future bride. He purchased his farm in 1883 from Edwin Berry, which he operated for 33 yrs. We are amused to learn he was known as "Elder Berry", an Elder in neighboring church. 1898 a new brick house was built which has been restored and occupied by his great-grandson and wife. This house is very distinctive; the only brick house in rural Martin County. Huge field stones were used for the foundation of the 12 room house which had a full basement. A unique building which is still on the farm, is a cement block bldg. -- 1/2 bldg. used for storing ice which was cut from lakes in winter, the other 1/2 bldg. had two rooms - one for smoking meat; the other room stored large crocks for preserving meat in salt brine and used as a cooler. Beef was canned in fruit jars; a real delicacy. One of the first farms to have electricity - batteries stored electricity used for milking and pumping water. First rural areas to have self-maintained telephone line for 14 farms. Lena Ledebur and George Meschke were married 1915 and celebrated Golden Anniversary in 1965. Lena, who is now 92 yrs. old, lived on same farm until 1980; now a resident of Methodist Home. In 1926 a devastating fire destroyed 7 barns, and favorite team of horses and livestock. The family has been dedicated to Community and Church. 60 year members of Farm Bureau, 20 yrs. 4-H leader, George served 30 yrs. Fair Board, Director of P.C.A. 20 yrs. Earle served Fairmont School Board 12 yrs.; Director of Federal Land Bank-15 yrs. Director
