They homesteaded on adjacent frams in Erhards Grove Township. Anders Jonsson and Mrs. Carl Larson were brother and sister. In fact, a $2\frac{1}{2}$ area piece of land was sold to Carl Larson by Anders P. Jonsson for the sum of \$15.00 in 1892 because the land was not platted correctly and Mr. Larson's home was build on Mr. Jonsson's land!

The estate of Anders Jonsson was willed to Anna K. Kjernstrom who cared for Mr. and Mrs. Jonsson in their later years. Anna Kjerstrom was the grand-mother of Albert J. Johnson who married Elizabeth R. Carlson (great-grand-daughter of Carl Larson).

Anna and John Kjernstrom deeded the farm to J. N. Johnson, in 1919.

John Nick Johnson sold the farm to Albert J. and Elizabeth (Carlson) Johnson in 1940. The farm was bought from the estate of Albert J. Johnson in 1968 by Roger (Johnson) and Kathleen Bergren, the present owners.

The Larson farm is still owned by Mr. Larson's great-grandson, Larry E. and Carol Carlson.
