If the change you appealed for is still not granted, and if the property in question is your homestead, or if not your homestead, the assessor's estimated market value is less than \$100,000, you can contact the Court Administrator to find out how you can make your third appeal to the Small Claims Division of the Minnesota Tax Court. If the property is not your homestead and the assessor's estimated market value is over \$100,000, you can make your third appeal to the Regular Division of the Minnesota Tax Court.

YOU CANNOT APPEAL TO YOUR COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION WITHOUT HAVING FIRST APPEALED TO YOUR CITY OR TOWN BOARD OF REVIEW. And you cannot appeal to the Small Claims Division of the Minnesota Tax Court without first having appealed both to your city or town Board of Review and county Board of Equalization. The market value of your property multiplied by the percentage assigned to your property class, by the State Legislature, determines what percent you will pay of the total amount of property tax your community government will collect from all property owners next year. Two different properties can have exactly the same market values, but if they are in different classes the owner of the property in the class which has been assigned the lower percentage will pay a smaller percent of the community's total property tax.

YOU CAN APPEAL YOUR MARKET VALUE AND PROPERTY CLASS

If you believe that the estimate of your property's market value is wrong, or that your property is in the wrong class, you can appeal to as many as three successively higher authorities to have the market value or property class changed. Make your first appeal by speaking to your city or town Board of Review at the meeting on the date printed on the front of this card, or by sending a written appeal or a representative to speak for you.

If the change you appealed for is not granted, you can make an appointment with your county auditor to make your second appeal by speaking to your county Board of Equalization at the meeting on the date printed on the front of this card. Or you can send a representative or a written appeal.

If the change you appealed for is still not granted, and if the property in question is your homestead, or if not your homestead, the assessor's estimated market value is less than \$100,000, you can contact the Court Administrator to find out how you can make your third appeal to the Small Claims Division of the Minnesota Tax Court. If the property is not your homestead and the assessor's estimated market value is over \$100,000, you can make your third appeal to the Regular Division of the Minnesota Tax Court.

YOU CANNOT APPEAL TO YOUR COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION WITHOUT HAVING FIRST APPEALED TO YOUR CITY OR TOWN BOARD OF REVIEW. And you cannot appeal to the Small Claims Division of the Minnesota Tax Court without first having appealed both to your city or town Board of Review and county Board of Equalization. Appeals to the Regular Division of the Minnesota Tax Court can now be made directly and no other appearances are required. All appeals to Tax Court must be filed on or before May 15 of the year following the assessment.
