but did not file for the homestead until 1898. Crookston Minnesota was
quite a distance from Frazee Minnesota so it was a long trip in those days.
Then he heard that someone else tried to file on the 160 acres he was living
on, so he made the trip and filed for his homestead parcel.
When the first children got old enough to help Grandma farm, Grandpa
Meik worked for Great Northern Railroad for four to five years to help pay
for farm equipment.
The grainery which is the only original building left from the homestead
was used for many wedding dances, as the Toad Lake Hall wasn't built until
1925.
The 40 acres were purchased in 1919 for \$16.50 per acre.



#### THE FREDRICK FAMILY HISTORY

### WRITTEN BY TED ROEMER, Madison Lake MN

NICHOLAS FREDERICK, SENIOR, (3/13/1828 - 11/2/1910) WAS BORN IN ELASSE-LORRAINE ON THE FRENCH-GERMAN BORDER, ON MARCH 13, 1828. IN 1853, AT THE AGE OF 25, NICHOLAS MARRIED ROSE BUCKSTAL (4/10/1832 - 3/26/1903). EVENTUALLY TO THIS UNION 16 CHILDREN WERE BORN (7 BOYS AND 9 GIRLS). SHORTLY AFTER THE MARRIAGE, NICHOLAS, ROSE AND 6 WEEK-OLD INFANT SON STEPHAN CAME TO AMERICA. THE FAMILY FIRST SETTLED IN TOLEDO, CHIO. THREE MORE SON WERE BORN THERE, NICHOLAS (DIED IN INFANCY), JOHN AND PETER. IN 1863 THE FAMILY CAME TO MINNESOTA. THEY BOUGHT A HOME IN LE RAY TOWNSHIP NEAR MADISON LAKE. THE FREDERICK'S BOUGHT 160 ACRES OF MOSTLY FORESTED LAND AND A GREAT AMOUNT OF LABOR WAS REQUIRED TO CLEAR THE LAND FOR CULTIVATION. THERE WERE NO NEARBY RAILRAODS AND SUPPLIES HAD TO BE CARRIED OVERLAND FROM MANKATO. IT WAS ON THIS FARM THAT 12 MORE CHILDREN WERE BORN: JOSEPH, NICHOLAS, JR., MRS. JOE KLASEUS, MRS. HENRY POTZ, MARY O'MALLEY, MRS. FRANK VOLK, MRS. K.A. WETHALL, KATIE FALLING, ANNA CAVNAUGH, CAROLINE DEGLMAN, HENRY (DIED AT AGE 24) AND THERESA (DIED AT AGE 14).

NICHOLAS, JR., THE MAN AND HIS FAMILY WE ARE HONORING, HAD THE DISTINCTION OF HAVING SPECIAL HONOR BY HIS FATHER. THE FIRST SON NICHOLAS, DIED AS A CHILD. HIS FATHER WANTED A NAMESAKE. THUS THE THIRD SON BORN WAS OUR NICHOLAS. EVERYONE IN THE YEARS FOLLOWING, CALLED HIM "NICK" FREDERICK. WE WILL DO THE SAME.

NICK WAS BORN ON HIS DAD'S FARM NEAR MADISON LAKE IN BLUE EARTH COUNTY, SEPTEMBER 17, 1866. IT WAS ONE-HALF MILE WEST OF THE FARM ON WHICH NICK LIVED FOR THE REST OF HIS LIFE.

NICK WAS MARRIED TO MARY KRAMER OF THE CLEVELAND, MN AREA (1/15/1880 - 1/28/1956) IN SEPTEMBER OF 1896. MARY HAD BEEN A COUNTRY SCHOOL TEACHER AT AGE 16.

NICK STARTED FARMING ON THIS 42 ACRES HE HAD PURCHASED FROM HIS DAD'S 160 ACRE HOMESTEAD, APRIL 27, 1896. HE PAID \$500 FOR IT. LATER, WITH THE HELP OF HIS 8 BOYS (MARY AND NICK RAISED 8 BOYS AND 4 GIRLS), HE FARMED OVER 500 ACRES WITH 14 HORSES. HE NEVER DROVE A TRACTOR. AS HIS FAMILY GREW, HE HAD NEUBERT CONSTRUCTION CO. CF MANKATO BUILD HIM A LARGER, 5-BEDROOM HOUSE, IT'S COSTS COMPLETE - \$3,000. THE YEAR, 1917.

HIS YOUNGEST SON, CLETE, AND HIS WIFE, VALERIA, NOW LIVE IN IT. CLETE SAYS, "I WAS BORN IN THAT FRONT BEDROOM: I STILL SLEEP IN IT."

THE STORIES OF NICK AROUND MADISON LAKE ARE LEGEND. HE WAS A GOOD MIXER, A GOOD FARMER, A GOOD PROVIDER, A GOOD CHURCH MAN AND A GOOD NEIGHBOR. HE NEVER MISSED ATTENDING A FUNERAL. HE WAS A MEMBER OF MANY MADISON LAKE ORGANIZATIONS, AMONG THEM THE ST. JOSEPH SOCIETY, THE GERMAN AID SOCIETY, AND THE CATHOLIC ORDER OF FORESTERS. HIS WIFE AND CHILDREN, OF GERMAN HERITAGE, WERE BLESSED WITH MUSICAL TALENT. FOR YEARS MARY WAS ORGANIST AT ALL SAINTS CHURCH AND ALL THEIR CHILDREN ATTENDED ALL SAINTS SCHOOL AND SANG IN THE CHOIR. LIZZIE (MRS. HERMAN MUELLERLEILE) WAS AN ESPECIALLY GIFTED CONTRALTO. CLETE FREDERICK ALSO WAS EXCEPTIONALLY GIFTED. HIS TIMING WAS EXCELLENT ON THE DRUMS AND HE PLAYED WITH MANY BANDS AND EVENTUALLY ORGANIZED HIS OWN BAND - "THE CAVALIERS". HE PLAYED OVER A SPAN OF 52 YEARS. AND HE IS STILL PLAYING. PAUL FREDERICK IS ALSO A LOCAL MUSICAL LEGEND SINGING AT MANY WEDDINGS, FUNERALS AND CHURCH SERVICES.

THE EARLY "DIRTY THIRTIES" WERE THE WORST FARMING YEARS, NICK ONCE SAID. GRAIN PRICES WERE ON THE ROCKS; DROUGHT AND DUST, A CONTINUAL PLAGUE. HE LOST SEVEN HORSES THOSE YEARS. 





He was nominated by the Democrats on different occasions as representative in the house, and also for the state senate. For many years he has been a member of the Democratic state central committee.

#### OLE C. LUND

Ole C. Lund, in whose career is found a striking illustration of the possibilities of the northwest for men of energy and industry, and who is now living on his well appointed farm in section 26, Tansem township, Clay county, was born in Trandjem, Norway, in 1845, on a farm, where his father had for years devoted himself to the cultivation of the soil, and where young Ole remained until he was seventeen years of age. Then he went to Sweden and found work in a lumber yard and remained there until twenty-one years old. At that period in his life he left home and became a sailor of the ocean, his first trip being across the world to Australia, thence to Peru and return around Cape Horn. For eight years Mr. Lund was a sailor and proved himself a daring and adventurous young man, ready for any call and equal to any duty. He visited in the course of his voyaging all parts of the world, and was at Manila five months. He was in North and South America, at Alexandria, Egypt, and elsewhere, acquiring a fund of general information as to the character and habits of the different nations that make him a most interesting conversationalist. His last experiences as a sailor were had on the Great Lakes in North America; and giving up a life on the water, he worked four months in the iron mines of Michigan. For a short time he was engaged in farming in Wisconsin, and in the fall of 1874 located on a homestead claim in section 26. Tansem township, Clay county, Minnesota. He built a shanty, 14x16 feet, and applied himself to the making of a farm home out of the prairie wilderness. During his first years on the homestead he had to contend against all sorts of difficulties, principally the grasshopper plague, but he persevered, and now has a fine standing in the agricultural and business world.

For three seasons he worked on a flat boat on the Red river, and in 1877 bought a threshing machine, and engaged in the occupation of grain threshing, which has been his work every season to the present time, and in that long period wearing out three sets of threshing outfits. In the prosecution of this business Mr. Lund has been all over this part of the state.

Mr. Lund was married, in 1876, to Miss Johanna Johnson, a native of Norway, and an

emigrant to this country in 1874. Her father died in Minnesota. To this marriage has come a family of seven children: Kia M., Ida, Robert, Olaf, Jalmer, Olga and Ragenor, all born on the farm where they are now growing to maturity, a rugged and interesting family of young people.

Mr. Lund owns a farm of two hundred and eighty acres, with one hundred and fifty acres under active cultivation. His house is large and commodious, and the barn and other buildings equal to all the requirements of the place. His wheat has run from thirteen to fifty bushels to the acre, and he is now working into stock.

In politics Mr. Lund is a Populist, and has been chairman of the town board for nine years. He takes an active interest in town affairs. In the various county conventions of his party he has for years been an influential worker.

#### WILLIAM G. CAMERON, M. D.

Although this gentleman has been a resident of Staples, Minnesota, comparatively few years, he has rapidly risen in prominence as a physician and worthy citizen, and he now enjoys the patronage of the people and the highest esteem of all with whom he has to do. He is a gentleman of excellent knowledge of his profession, having attained a high standard of theoretical knowledge through the colleges which he has attended, and also practical knowledge by his experiences in the leading hospitals in the east and his observations and careful study while engaging in the practice of medicine.

Dr. Cameron was born in New York, November 3, 1873, and was a son of Alexander and Mary K. (Fulton) Cameron, the former a native of Scotland and the latter of Ireland. He was left an orphan at the age of four years, and resided thereafter with his brother at Traverse City, Michigan. He there attended the high school until he was'seventeen years of age, when he secured employment in a retail book and stationery establishment, and during the same year established a business for himself in that line. He handled all the daily papers and was circulating manager of the Daily Eagle, of Traverse City, until 1893, when he disposed of his business interests and began a course of study at the University of Pennsylvania. He attended that institution four years, and graduated from the medical department, in 1897, with the degree of M. D. He had his first practice in Chester hospital, at Chester, Pennsylvania, and also worked at the St. Christopher hospital at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. In 1898 he came to Brainerd, Minnesota, as assistant physician for the Northern Pacific hospital, and was there engaged two years, when he located in Staples and opened his office. William Clark Nelson's farm was originally two homesteads. Clark's father, William A. Nelson homesteaded the NW quarter of Section 2, Leon Township, Clearwater County. The NE quarter was homesteaded by Henry Bertram Perkins.

Henry Bertram Perkins, (called Bert) of Bertha MN, accompanied by his brother-in-law, William A. Nelson, in 1897 came to look at the land newly opened for homesteading in Beltrami County. Bert was looking for timber land and found what he wanted in what is now Clearwater County. They filed on adjoining claims and helped each other build their log cabins before leaving for home.

William A. and Bert came back late the next fall and found that some of their best timber was being stolen, so William staid and Bert went back to Bertha for William A.'s family and helped them move to their homestead. Bert spent the next few winters helping harvest timber, and after the windstorm of 1902, in clearing his land for farming.

Bert married Anna Current in 1920 and brought his wife to his claim on which he had built a house and granary. However, Anna was not happy there and he took her back to Bertha. After that he rented his land to William A. and later to William's son Clark, who bought Bert's land in the early 1940's, adding it to the land his father had homesteaded.

Our family has the original deed to Henry Bertram Perkins homestead. Since Clark is now 90 years of age, he has begun the formation of a trust to transfer ownership of the farm to his children. Evidently the bill of sale transferring the property from Bert Perkins to his nephew Clark Nelson is in the possession of the lawyers handling the trust. We do have a copy of the warranty deed transferring rights from Clark to the Nelson Family Trust. I hope this information does not muddy the Century farm application too much.

Although the property is gradually being transferred out of Clark's name, it continues to be farmed by his children and grandchildren in the area, who have adjoining land. "Uncle Bert's Place", as it is known to family members, has been a part of "Grandpa's Farm" for so long that we have filed the Century Farm Application with both properties included in the legal description of the land.
