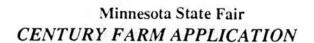

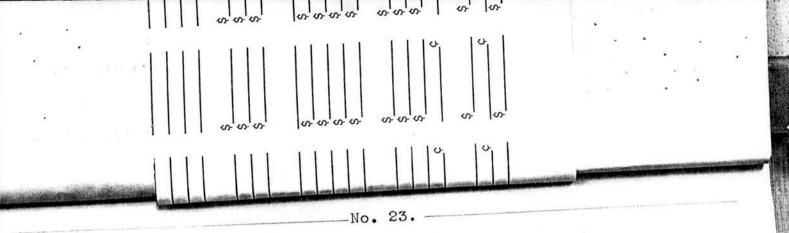

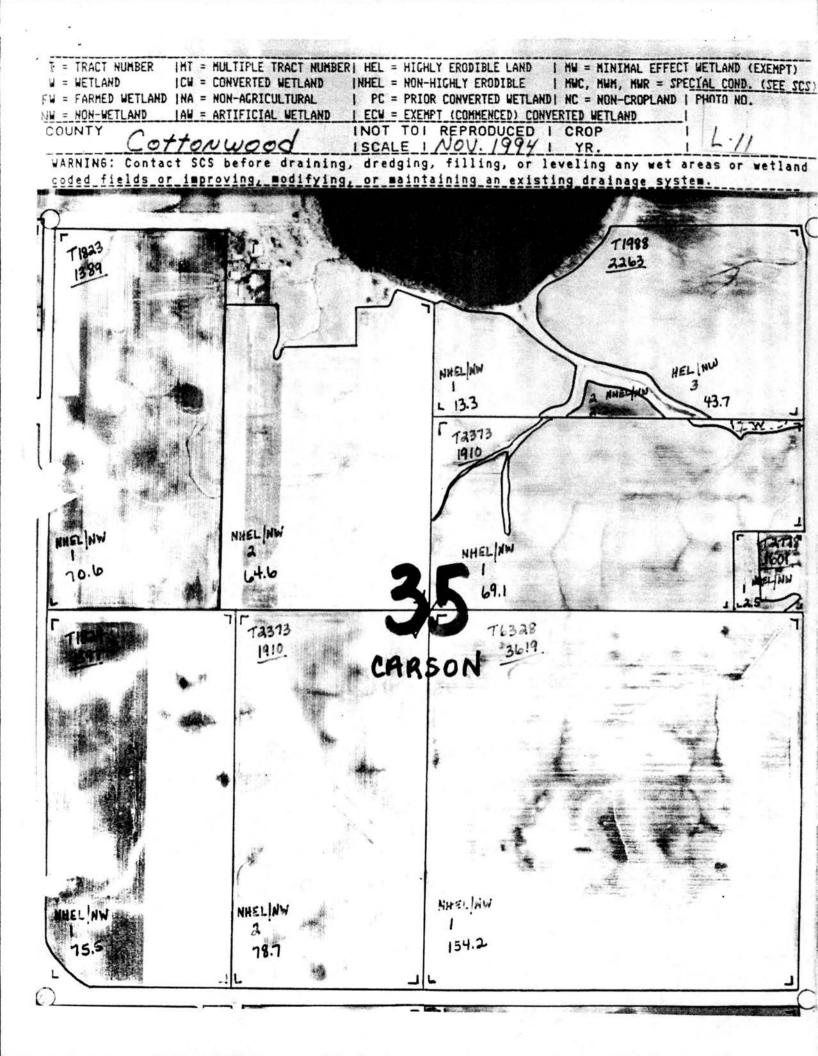

The winter and spring of 1891-92 brought tragedy to the Peter Lorentz farm which is located about six miles northeast of Cannon Falls. Peter Lorentz died in November of 1891 at the age of 30. His wife, Emma Engel Lorentz, died in March of 1892 at the age of 31.

Four little children were left without parents. Frank was six, Margaret was four, Jacob was two and Susan was newborn.

It was Emma's dying request that her family be kept together. The Engel relatives took the children and kept them at the homes of Emma's sisters and her mother, Margaretha Engel.

At one time, Grandma Engel decided to have the four children attend a boarding school in New Ulm. The older children could remember the trip from Vermillion to New Ulm by horse and buggy. The nuns there cared for the children for a year or more through holidays and vacations. New Ulm was a long way from Vermillion. At that time Frank was

about eight, Margaret was about six, Jacob about four and Susie was a toddler. Frank and Margaret remember Susie having a baby bottle with a hose attached and a nipple at the end of the hose. After that the The Rouse Irank built before he married 35

children were returned to the homes of the Engel relationship. Later Frank worked for room and

board and a small allowance. After he died, the family found a notebook record of every cent earned and spent. Early on, he knew the value of a penny!

The farm was kept in the Peter and Emma Lorentz estate. Peter's brother Jacob staved with Emma after her husband's death until she died the following spring. Then another brother of Peter's, Marcus Lorentz, rented the farm until Peter's son Frank took over the farm in about 1908 at the age of /8 sister! In Margaret's later years, That farm is now owned and operated by Jack Lorentz and his family.

So the Lorentz farm was passed on to four generations. From Peter Lorentz to son Frank, then to Frank's son Jerome, the grandson of Peter.

Jerome passed the farm to his son Jack, great-grandson of Peter.

Hopefully, there will always be a Lorentz with foresight and planning!

When it was decided that Frank was old enough to take over the Lorentz farm, he asked his sister Margaret to join him and keep house for him. What a homecoming for brother and a granddaughter asked her what was the happiest day of her life. Without hesitation she replied "When brother Frank asked me to come and keep house for him."

After some years Frank decided to build a new house. What an experience for these young people! That house is still occupied today by Jack Lorentz and family. Through the years this home held the Lorentz families in love and togetherness as complete families. Fater 97
