



The S 1/2 of the S 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of Section 4, (40 acres) was originally part of the Shirk Homestead. The Shirk Homestead was located on the NW 1/4 of Section 4 Seely Township and the S 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 33 Brush Creek Township (just north of Seely Township) and consisted of 240 acres.

The first traceable lineage in the Shirk Family begins with Ullrich Shirk I who was born in Berne, Switzerland in 1665. In 1730, his 6 sons and 6 daughters brought them to America and they settled in Lancaster County, Pennsylvania and took out patents for more than 2000 acres of land.

Ullrich Shirk II was one of those sons who was born in 1704. He became a respected Mennonite plantation owner.

Ullrich Shirk III, son of Ullrich II, was born in 1751 at his home in Schoeneck, Cocalico township, Lancaster County, PA. and lived on the home farm his whole life.

Jacob Shirk I, son of Ullrich III was born in 1796. He bought a farm in nearby Clay township, Lancaster County, PA. where he lived his life.

Jacob E. Shirk II, son of Jacob Shirk I, was born in Lancaster County Pennsylvania, in a community of Mennonite Followers. He became a seaman and had been on a whaling expedition before enlisting in the U.S. Navy in 1852. He was with Commadore Perry when the U.S. signed a trade pact

with Japan which opened their ports to commerce with the U.S.

Jacob E. Shirk II and his wife Catherine moved to
Faribault County, Minnesota after their marriage in 1858.
He obtained a Military Land Warrant for the Shirk Homestead
on January 30, 1860. They built their farm on the north
side of the East Fork of the Blue Earth River. They became
the first settlers of Seely Township, and their son Great
Grandfather Jefferson Shirk was the first white child born
in Seely Township.

Also, in the early 1870's, the east half of this 40 acres became the site of the village of Clayton. On the south side of the East Fork of the Blue Earth River, the Clayton School, a church (now located in Bricelyn) and Cemetery (Clayton Cemetery Assn. Established in 1874) as well as other buildings housing businesses were built and later moved to Bricelyn when the railroad came through. The Clayton Cemetery takes out 1 acre of the 200 acre farm making it 199 acres.

Great Grandfather Jefferson built a new house on this farm in 1916 which is the current house. My grandfather Bruce Shirk was 8 when the house was built, and he helped haul the lumber from Wells.

Jefferson formally named this farm the "Clayton Stock
Farm" in 1916 after the house was built. A sign was placed
on the barn saying "CLAYTON STOCK FARM", and when I moved
here in 1976, I removed the sign which was barely legible to

paint the very weathered barn. In 1996, I repainted the barn again and when it was done, I remembered the old sign I had put in the grainery. When I found it, it was in pretty good shape except you could barely see the letters. I repaired the bad edging and my kids repainted the sign. We put it back up on the barn where it belongs and now everyone who visits wants to know the history of this farm.

My father and mother, Roger and Corinne Shirk, and myself bought this farm with a contract for deed from our aunt and cousins in 1976. In 1994, I bought out the contract from my parents so I am now the sole owner of the Shirk Farm.

I extensively remodeled the farm home in the winters of 1977, '78, and '79, taking out the stoker coal furnace which was still being used, and rewired the home. This house had its own power plant using batteries and a small generator before the REA brought power to the area. I also added all new plumbing and heating, insulation, and sheetrocked the entire house. The beautiful woodwork, pantry, fireplace, and window seat still remain. For 21 years now, this has been our home.



In1869, Ola and Margareta (Olsdotter) Anderson came over from Trolle Ljungby, Sweden and settled in the Vasa area. They arrived with six children and two more were born in Vasa.

Son, Ola (Ole) Jr., married Alma Olson and in 1891 they purchased 40 acres in Cannon Falls twp, Section #24 and an adjoining 24 acres in Vasa twp, Section #19.

Eventually they purchased an additional 120 acres, in Cannon Falls twp, Section #24, making a total of 184 acres. Ola (Ole) Jr. and Alma had eight children: Arthur, Lillie, Ethel, Pearl, Winfred, Irene, Delmer, and Alton.

Son, Winfred, married Annie Aslakson, from Mineola twp, in 1925, and farmed with Ole and Alma. Later, Ole and Alma moved to Cannon Falls and in 1937 they both passed away and Winfred and Annie purchased the farm. They had five children: Doris (Paul) Landon, Donna (Lawrence) Pasch, Donald (Dorothy), Russell (Elizabeth), and Ardis (Charles) Durdahl. They continued farming until Winfred passed away in 1963. Annie continued to live on the farm till she passed away at age 89, on Jan.12,1990.

Son, Donald, and his wife Dorothy (Schwartau), purchased the farm in 1963 and own it at the present time. The land was farmed until 1986. In 1986 it was accepted into the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP) and will remain in that program thru 2008. My dad Donald Schreader got this application for me to fill out. We had not sent one in sooner as we were not sure if we had 100 year actual ownership. We had showed the abstract to a local attorney before to read it legally. There have been Schreader's living on the farm since about 1893. The Schreader family lived in the house and farmed the land continually since then. Technically and legally around 1910 they did borrow some money from a close relative and that relative had a temporary quick claim deed as security on the loan. The Schreader family continued to live in the house and farm the land during this loan. We had not sent in a application before as this quick claim deed did technically and legally break the chain of Schreader ownership. But my dad said he did not think that you were quite that fussy and as long as Schreaders continued to operate the farm that this might be OK. and the loan was from a close relative.
