



the first farm in Holland Twsp., Kandiyohi Co in 1896. It was called "The Home Place". It was
said that Grandpa bought more land whenever he had an extra dollar in his pocket. The 1905
Kandiyohi County History states that he now owns 960 acres in Holland Iwsp. He wanted a farm
for each of their 13 children and wanted them living close enough to be able to visit often.
He achieved his goal. My father and his brother bought the farm in sec. 33 in 1911. Dad
was a better farmer than Grandpa. He spent hia farming years clearing the farm of rocks left
by the glacier. The rocks were hauled to the center of the farm and soon grew to a huge pile.
He hired a road contractor, who came with dragline and bulldozer, to bury the pocks. It took
five days to dig the trench, push the rocks in and cover them up. During World War II this
farm was rated the highest producing farm in Holland Twsp. We rented the farm at first and
then bought the north 80acres with buildings in 1948and the south 80 in 1961. We have done our
share of rock hauling, also. We still live on the farm. Our son now rents the land and adds
to the collection of rocks. It is good productive land.
Today, 1997, there are only 11 decendents of Klass and Grietje who are farming and only
3 of them are on the original land that Grandpa and Grandma bought.

I had an opportunity to review the abstract of title in response to your request concerning the possibility of qualifying the farm as a century family farm. It appears that part of the farmland described as the East Half of the East Half, less the west 15 rods of the south 18 rods, of Section 28, Township 120, Range 44, has been in your family since 1886. The United States government through a United States patent, transferred the land to Ole Kittleson in 1882. The East Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 28 passed to a John Nelson in 1886 and then back to John Kittleson. John received the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 28 from Ole in 1886 and conveyed all of the above described land to Gilbert Kittleson in about 1898. Gilbert Kittleson's final decree in his estate conveyed the land to Anna, Elmer, Arnold, Gladys and Amanda. That was dated 1947. Anna and children conveyed their interest by Warranty Deed to Elmer in 1951. By Elmer's decree in his estate in 1983 the land came to your mother, Glenda. I hope this information might be useful to you in your efforts to qualify the farm as a century family farm.

When you get an opportunity we should touch base relative to all of your accounting and begin wrapping things up in completing the estate. I will look forward to hearing from you.

I found a copy of a handwritten biography for Peder Quaal - appears to be for the year 1904. I do not know who wrote it but I got it from Molly Lauritsen. It goes like this:

Peder Quaal (1904 - Biography)

Peder Quaal, one of the prominent and successful farmers of Ten Mile Lake Twp., Lac Qui Parle County, came of Norwegian nativety and is a worthy representative of the best traits of his race and blood. He was born on a farm in Trondhjem, Norway, in 1844. His father was a farmer who lived and died in his native land. Peder Quaal was the fifth member of a family of six children, and received such educational advantages as the time afforded. He spent his boyhood and youth in fishing and in mastering the carpenter trade. As a young man he served his time in the army and was then free to follow his own devices. In 1871, he came to the United States and locating in Ishpeming, Michigan, for five years worked in the iron mines in that vicinity. Here he was married in 1872 to Miss Anne Bye. She was also born in Norway, and has proved in every way a helpful companion to her husband. They have had a family of ten children: Andrew, Mary, Oluf, Mathilda, Christ, Rudolph, Sivert, Anne, Petra, and Adolph.

In 1876 Mr. Quaal brought his family to Lac Qui Parle County. Andrew, Mary, and Oluf were born in Michigan. Mathilda was the first white child born in Ten Mile Lake Township. Mr. Quaal settled on a pre-emption claim in Sec. 1, Ten Mile Lake Twp. Here, he put up a small house, 14 x 16 feet and entered upon the development of his wild prairie land. For 4 years he used oxen in doing his farm work, and then got some good horses. His nearest market place was Benson, thirty-seven miles away, and like other settlers of those early days, he has remembrances of hard times and much suffering, the winter of 1880-1881 being the most vivid in his memory, for its deep snow, its protracted cold, and the difficulty of securing needed provisions. Mr. Quaal owns a farm of 144 acres with good buildings and all the machinery the place requires. The grove, which is very thrifty, was planted by him and was almost his first work on the place. He has some fruit trees and is generally well fixed. The present house was built in 1894.

Mr. Quaal is a Republican and helped in the organization of the township, and was one of its first supervisors. He has also been on the town board.

Today I visited the Lac qui Parle County Courthouse and the Lac qui Parle County Historical Museum. While at the museum, I visited a display of Ten Mile Lake Township. There, I discovered a book called "History of Minnesota Valley" by Rev. Edward D. Neill - Northstar Publishing Company, Mpls., copyright 1882. On page 949 is the following information about Ten Mile Lake Township and Peter Quaal:

This town comprises congressional township 116-42. The town derives its name from the lake, which is ten miles from Lac qui Parle. The first settler was Peter Quale, who located on section 1 in 1876. The first town meeting was held at the house of Gregor Hanson, November 4, 1878; officers elected: Hans Amundson, chairman; Peter Quale and Gregor Hanson, supervisors; Ole K. Strand, clerk; Oliver Ryalen, justice; Martin Johnson, constable. There are no schools in the town.

Peter Quaal, Pioneer Resident of this Community, Passed Away Sunday 1844-1929

Peter Quaal, who had the distinction of being the first settler in the town of Ten Mile Lake, passed away at this home four miles northeast of Boyd shortly before 8:00 o'clock Sunday morning, August 25th, at the age of 85 years, four months and eight days. During his lifetime Mr. Quaal had practically no sickness until last autumn, when he became a victim to influenza. Altho greatly weakened by the ailment he was able to be about until within ten days of his demise. As the Sabbath morning dawned quiet and peaceful, so also ebbed away his life.

Mr. Quaal was born April 17, 1844 in Orkedalen, Trondhjem, Norway. In 1871 he came to America and entered upon employment in the iron mines near Ishpeming, Michigan, continuing in this work five years. In June 1872, he was united in marriage to Annie Bye. Learning that homestead land could be had in this section of Minnesota they came to Lac qui Parle county in 1876 and made settlement in Section 1, town of Ten Mile Lake, which has been continously their home. Supplying himself with a team of oxen Mr. Quaal hauled the lumber for their 14x16 ft. dwelling house from Benson, 37 miles distance. For several succeeding years it was necessary to go to Benson for provisions, and when it was not possible for the oxen to make their way thru the deep snow Mr. Quaal made the trip on skiis, at times bringing home thusly 100-lbs. of flour with the other food supplies. In those years Benson was also the nearest point for the marketing of grain.

To Mr. and Mrs. Quaal were born ten children, of who two preceded their father in death - Mrs. Fred Nesbitt, who passed away March 27, 1919, at Forbes, Minn., and Olaf, whose death occured April 8th, 1926, at Rose Valley, Sask., Canada. Surviving the deceased are his wife and the following children: Andrew, of Forbes, Minn.; Rudolph of Zenith, N.D.; Sivert of Camp Release; Mrs. S. L. Erickson and Mrs. O.C. Oie, of Montevideo; Christopher and Adolph, at home. Mr. Quaal is also survived by 40 grandchildren, 25 great grand children, a sister, residing in Norway and two nephews, Andrew Quaal of Silvertown, Oregon, and O. Olson of VanHook, N.D.

Funeral services took place Wedesday afternoon, at 1:00 o'clock from the home and 2:00 o'clock from St. Petri's Lutheran Free church in the town of Camp Release. The services were conducted by Rev. H. O. Lee of Madelia, former pastor of St. Petri's congregation and close friend of the deceased. Brief talks were also given by Rev. Elias Aas of Minneapolis, who became acquainted with Mr. Quaal 45 years ago, and Rev. Edwin Paulson, of Foley, a former near neighbor. Vocal solos were also supplied by Rev. Paulson and Mrs. H. O. Lee.

The services were very largely attended, including many acquaintances from the adjoining communities. Relatives from a distance present were Mr. and Mrs. L. Monseth of Minneota, L. O. Agre and family of Madison and Mr. and Mrs. John Donkersgoed and son Bernard of Baldwin, Wis. With the wealth of beautiful floral tributes there were also memorial money contributions for missions, church school and charities totaling \$40.00. Interment was made in the Lutheran Free church cemetery in Camp Release. The pall bearers were John Bye and the deceased's five sons.

The death of Mr. Quaal removes one more of the praiseworthy pioneers - one of those who endured and battled hardships uncomplainingly and with unfaltering determination. Thankful when the strife for a livelihood was favorable and putting more energy into the efforts when met by adversaries - such were they who conquered the prairies hereabouts and made possible the inviting farmsteads we now behold.

In addition to being the local township's first homesteader Mr. Quaal was also one of its first supervisors and took part in organizing the town government. Active in church affairs he was a charter member of the St. Petri Conference congregation. Mr. Quaal interested himself to a great extent in the temperance cause, giving generously of his means to this and to the furtherance of religion.

As a husband and father, Mr. Quaal filled his place nobly, and in return had the deep love of his family circle. His memory will also linger as a worthy citizen, a good neighbor and a friend in its truest meaning.

Ane Bye, daughter of Ole and Marit Bye, was born January 13, 1849, at Orkedalen, near Trondhjem, Norway. She grew to young womanhood in the land of her nativity and emigrated to America in 1872. Destination was Ishpeming, Michigan, where in June of that year she was united in marriage to Peter Quaal. In 1876 they moved from Ishpeming to homestead land northeast of Boyd, they being the first settlers in Ten Mile Lake township. Mrs. Quaal resided continuously at the original homestead for the long period of 69 years.

Deceased is preceded in death by her husband, who passed away August 25th, 1929, and four children, namely: Marie (Mrs. Fred Nesbitt), Olaf, Andrew, and Christopher. Children surviving ar Mrs. A. H. Nibbelink of Boyd, Rudolph of South Heart, N.D., Sivert of Camp Release township, Mrs. S.L. Erickson and Mrs. O.C. Oie of Montevideo, and Adolph of Ten Mile Lake township. Mrs. Quaal is also survived by 40 grandchildren, 43 great grandchildren and 9 great, great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon, at 1:30 o'clock from the home and 2:00 o'clock from the St. Petri Lutheran Free church in Camp Release Township. The services were conducted by the Rev. Miss Helen Krogstad served as accompanist, and also as organist at the service.

The rites were largely attended, and love and esteem was further attested to in numerous beautiful floral tributes and the contributions toward memorial wreaths in the amount of \$86.75.
