

Our farm now includes an acreage of what used to be the original community of Dovray. A few shops or buildings were located on the original east 80 and across from them was a one-room schoolhouse. After the railroad was built, the village of Dovray was moved one mile southwest of its original site so that it could service the trains engines and be closer to accommodate the shipments of products to and from the rail cars. The schoolhouse remained at the original site. During times of bad winter storms, the Knutson farm was often used to house the schoolteacher or other students who could not make it to their homes. Many of the original buildings of our farm have been destroyed or dismantled over the years. One tractor shed was destroyed in strong winds in 1968. The west addition to the Chicken barn was destroyed by fire in approximately 1974. However the original east side still stands today. The original granary and cornerib were replaced with a Machine Shed/Storage Bin and Grain Dryer in 1979. The unique old cedar silo was blown over by winds in the early 1980's. The original barn and hog house was dismantled the fall of 1994. The salvageable wood from the silo, barn and hog house has been used by our children in building their own house decks and machine sheds. Most recently a small tornado destroyed the two-stall garage. At this point the only original buildings still in use include the house, a brooderhouse and the east side of the chicken house.
