Qualifications for entry are as follows:

- The farm must be at least 100 years old this year (2016) according to abstract of title, land patent, original deed, county land records, court file in registration proceedings, or other authentic land records. Please do not send originals or copies of records.
- 2. Your family must have owned the farm for 100 years or more. "Family" is defined as parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters, sons, daughters, first cousins and direct in-laws (father, mother, brother, sister, daughter, son-in-law).
- Continuous residence on farm is not required, but ownership must be continuous.
- 4. The farm should consist of 50 or more acres, and currently be involved in agricultural production.

All of the qualifications must be met at the time the application is submitted. Recognition ceremonies are handled by the local county fair. If your county fair does not have a ceremony, your certificate and sign will be sent directly to you shortly after June 1. The Century Farm status is only conferred on a farm one time. New owners from the same "family", after a farm has already been designated a Century Farm, may not reapply or request a new certificate.

Benjamin, who served in World War I, had the distinction of being the first Brown County soldier to die in that war and

Is the original home or any other original buildings still standing?

The original hand hewn log home built in 1917 was dismantled and was re stacked ¾ miles north of the original site. It has a good roof on it, but is just in a storage state at this time. The old original barn is beyond repair, and the hay shed that was attached is still in use today. The large barn with a hay mow that was built in 1930 was just renovated and has a new roof, windows, floors, and the siding will be completed this summer.

The following is a story of the Heikkinen family that will be in the centennial book we are writing for our community centennial celebration.

Jaffet & Maria Heikkinen - Jaffet Heikkinen was born July 28, 1871 in the Suomussalmi area of Finland. His parents were Juho Heikkinen and Saara Luukkonen. Jaffet was the youngest of seven children and was only ten years old when his father died. Jaffet married Maria Kinnunen March 27, 1892 in Suomussalmi.

Maria was the only daughter of Martti Kinnunen and Anna Kaisa Vesteri. She had four younger brothers. On May 21, 1895 Maria's parents and brothers moved towards the Russian border and were never heard of again. Three weeks later Maria gave birth to her second child, Vilhelmina.

Jaffet and Maria had five children born to them but two died, one in infancy and daughter Amanda, age two, after receiving a vaccination. In the spring of 1903 Jaffet left his family in Finland and went to join his brother John near Alexandria, Minnesota. Shortly after leaving his pregnant wife, their daughter lda was born on May 25, 1903.

Two years later Jaffet sent money so the family could come to America. On May 4, 1905 Maria arrived at Boston with their four children on the ship Ivernia having sailed from Liverpool, England. With the aid of interpreters at Ellis Island and \$10 to her name arrangements were made for the family to take a train to Minnesota. She made her way to Holmes City and reunited with Jaffet where he had rented a farm. Together again as a family; three sons and a daughter were born to the couple at Holmes City. John was born in 1907, Reuben in 1910, Emil in 1913 and Edna in 1914, who died at six months of age. She was buried in Moe Township, Douglas County.

In 1916, Jaffet, Edwin Juntunen and Otto Salo came to Suomi and on 10 June each bought 80 acres of land from agents of the Pellervo Land Company of Duluth. These agents were Antero Havela and John Asiala who had procured the right to sell the lands of the Itasca Land Company. The men returned to Holmes City to complete the field work.

In September Jaffet and Otto returned to Suomi for three weeks and built a log cabin. In November Jaffet and Edwin returned to Suomi each with a team of horses with the intention of staying all winter. Jaffet's nephew Edward joined the men and they spent the winter of 1916 in Suomi doing some logging and cutting timber for their future homes. Jaffet's daughter, Annie, was along to cook for them. After seeing his Uncle established on his new land Edward left the next year.

In April of 1917 Edwin returned to Holmes City to bring his family and Mrs. Heikkinen to their land in Suomi. Edwin had married Jaffet's daughter Minnie and now had a 10 month old daughter, Marion. Shortly after arrival they began building their own log cabin. In May Jaffet, Maria and Otto returned to Holmes City to farm and to ready for the move to Suomi in the fall.

Otto Salo recalled the lumber and stove for the Heikkinen home was hauled from Suomi station, a distance of about three miles. With the house completed the Heikkinen family moved here November 8, 1917. In June of 1918 the Suomi Church was organized at the Heikkinen home. The community

changed its name from Elbow to Suomi. That same summer the first car came to Suomi with men to look for a school site. A one-room school was constructed and thirteen children enrolled for the fall term. The fall of 1918 kept the men busy fighting forest fires that threatened their homes. At this time Suomi was a community of some 30 individuals.

In November of 1918 the influenza epidemic hit the Suomi area, with sickness in every home. The Heikkinen family suffered a terrible blow. Jaffet and his two sons, John and Emil died of the flu; John, age 12 on November 8th, Emil, age 5, on the 9th, and Jaffet on the 16th, leaving Maria with two sons, Joe and Reuben, and daughters Annie and Ida. Mrs. Heikkinen recalled with gratitude how the young people of Suomi came each evening to sing and comfort her in her grief. Maria had now lost five children and a husband in death. The three were buried on the Heikkinen farm until a church cemetery was established and their remains were transferred to the cemetery in 1920.

It was during this trying time that a ray of hope passed through the community. Otto Salo was in the Army in France when train whistles could be heard blowing in Deer River. It was November 11th and World War I was over. Unknown to the people of Suomi, Otto had been shot through the neck the previous day and was lying in an Army ambulance struggling for his life.

Due to being drafted Otto had sold his land in Suomi and left for service 27 May 1918. After recovering from his wounds he returned to Suomi in 1919 and was shocked to learn of the deaths of Jaffet, John and Emil. Otto had secretly planned to marry Ida Heikkinen, but she was too young. Now that she was older, he asked, she consented and they were married 10 July 1920.

Mrs. Heikkinen lived on the homestead until Reuben married, when she moved to a small cabin on the Otto Salo place. Later she lived with her daughter, Ida, and then Minnie, until shortly before her death at the County Home on February 8, 1965. Had she lived until her birthday on March 24, she would have been 95 years old.

Mrs. Heikkinen's surviving children were Annie who married Isaac Beck, then Emil Lehtonen, Minnie who married Edwin Juntunen, Joe who married Ella Ekholm, Ida married Otto Salo, and Reuben who married Beatrice Talcott.

Then we made our living room large enough to stack them all back inside. It turned out great. The barn which was completed in 1921 and added on to in the 1950's is still standing strong.

Addition comments:

My Grandfather, Edwin Juntunen, his father- In –Law Jaffet Heikkinen, and friend Otto Salo, all came to the area to buy land on June 10th, 1916. They were the first ones to come buy land and start the newly formed community. The lumber companies had just left the area after all the pine was cut off and the land was put up for sale. Many settlers of Finnish decent settled here within a few short years and the area became known as Suomi. 2016 is our community's centennial celebration and my wife and I are very involved in this endeavor, with myself serving as chairman of the committee.

- The farm must be at least 100 years old this year (2016) according to abstract of title, land patent, original deed, county land records, court file in registration proceedings, or other authentic land records. Please do not send originals or copies of records.
- Your family must have owned the farm for 100 years or more. "Family" is defined as parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, brothers, sisters, sons, daughters, first cousins and direct in-laws (father, mother, brother, sister, daughter, son-in-law).
- Continuous residence on farm is not required, but ownership must be continuous.
- The farm should consist of 50 or more acres, and currently be involved in agricultural production.

All of the qualifications must be met at the time the application is submitted. Recognition ceremonies are handled by the local county fair. If your county fair does not have a ceremony, your certificate and sign will be sent directly to you shortly after June 1. The Century Farm status is only conferred on a farm one time. 
