Because of the passing of my mother on august 4th 2015 now once again it will be handed down in the family. Per my mothers wishes the bulk of the farm will go to my Son Brandon Tyler Silker age 23. Reason for mentioning his age is he will be the youngest owner of the farm in the history of the farm. Currently the owner of record is Betty Dorsey Silker. Once Probate is completed Brandon Tyler Silker will be the next owner of record, 6th generation living here.

I am not sure as far as whom you would put on any paper work or plaque, But both Brandon and I are ok with honoring my mother Betty Dorsey Silker. Here is why, My mother Loved her father Merlin Dorsey and her grandfather Mike Dorsey very much and in fact so much she changed her name in the 80s to reflect that. Her name at birth was Betty Jean Dorsey. Her Marriage to Vern Silker changed her last name to Silker. So to Honor the memory of Father and Grandfather she changed it to Betty Dorsey Silker.

We have a rich history in Olmsted county and Kalmar Township and its something to be proud of. Dating all the way back to John Soble known as the first settler to come to Byron (Bear Grove) area. In 1853 he arrived to find no one here and returning in 1854 to make it his home. Several history books along with websites tell this story as well. After settling in 1854 his other brothers Jacob and David came as well. Last was his sister Phoebe and we are all there descendants.

Event timeline

Time line author Robert Silker

1853 John Soble (Great Great Uncle) comes to minnesota to find no one here yet in this area. He returns to back east.

1854 John Soble returns to find a very small settlement of people so he settles here as well, Soon to be known as Bear Grove. I believe there was only 3 other families living here then.

John Soble gets word back east of the settlement and Brother David H. Soble with Brother Jacob W Soble makes a settlement in 1856 Known as the West 80 (acres). This is our starting point on our land today. Land first deed was to David H Soble in June 8th 1858.

First shack or house was built with a room for the horses in 1856 later becoming a barn, then a chicken coop with storage for the model a ford.

Also Isaac Johnston settled here in 1856. You will see why this is important later as he had a Daughter in August 5th 1903 named Beatrice Johnston.

Some time in the spring 1859 sister Phoebe Soble (Great Great Great grandmother) arrives and meets John Parish and they are wed in November 6th 1859.

Sometime in 1858-60 a new house was built still one room but much nicer than the shack. No Running water or bathroom. Still stands today with upgrades. Made in the 1860s Kitchen, Extra bedroom and hand pumped water from a cistern. Still no bathroom. Not sure of the bathroom or when but grandma said it was a big

deal. I think the bathroom came in the 1930s My grandfather Merlin put it in.

John and Phoebe Parish have a daughter in June 6th 1862 named Ada (Soble) Parish.

1864-5 the Railroad comes though the north part of our farm. The township of Bear Grove is renamed by S.W.VanDusen and called Byron after his hometown in Byron, New York.

Ada Soble Parish (Great Great Grandmother) Marries Mike Dorsey in september 14th 1888 they have a son in April 7th 1898 Merlin Dorsey.

Oct. 5th 1891 David H Soble deeds the farm and other land to Phoebe Soble Parish, Now totaling 65 acres and other land. (I remember a story about a horse being traded for the 24 acres as I do not know how the farm got the 24 acres) Also that this was supposed to be a wedding gift David gave to her in 1959. Also that David had moved on to other things in 1860.

Oct 27th 1919 Ada Parish Dorsey is awarded the land through probate on her mother Phoebe's passing.

1920 landmark building that still stands today. In 1920 a new barn was erected measuring 45x35 standing 37ft tall. This was a big deal at the time and one of the biggest barns in the Byron area. The Cost of the barn was \$2200.00. In 1922 a loan was taken to pay off the cost of building it with the Byron Bank this became the most fearful time of the family history. To this day all successors and airs must promise too never mortgage the property. Ada Dorsey was so scared they would loose the place it was unreal. As grandmother Dorsey put it she was hell to live with but you Kept Still and never spoke your mind. Based on records I understand,

plus the pending depression. Add the fact that the loan was paid off in Sept 29th 1925 but not recorded until 1928 I understand her fear. It was said that the bank held this over their head for 3 years trying to force them to barrow more money. They never barrowed any more money ever! The bank finally gave in and released the mortgage in 1928.

1922 Merlin Dorsey Meets Beatrice Johnston Daughter of Isaac Johnston and they are wed on October 24th 1924. Thus, My entry earlier about the Isaac Johnston family.

1929 Old #7 road turns into Hwy 14 coming through the south part of our land. Nabor, Melee Conway was so upset that they would cut down her apple trees that the engineers moved the road slightly to the north to save the trees. So happy she made the whole crew pies. Now known as Country Club Road West, Prior names were ol#7, Old 14, County 34

January 16th 1930 Merlin and Beatrice Dorsey have a daughter Betty Jean Dorsey

September 27th 1947 Mike Dorsey and son Merlin inherit the land from wife Ada Parish Dorsey.

In January 7th 1950 Betty Dorsey weds Vernon Silker and as a wedding gift from Merlin and Beatrice Dorsey they are gifted a 1 acre of land to build a house on. Recorded on Sept 22 1950.

1959 New Hwy 14 project is commenced and takes up a large part of our north part of the land. We lost our spring fed pond and several acres of the best land we had. It covered about 15 acres leaving us with about 71 acres tillable. Side note here. I spoke with a man that remembers drag racing on the new road before it was even open. He will go unmentioned.

April 15th 1960 Betty and Vernon Silker have a son named Robert William Silker named after uncle William Dorsey, known lovingly as uncle Bill. He had passed as a young man but Betty thought dearly of him and wanted to honor him.

1981 February 26th the land is deeded over to Daughter and husband Betty Dorsey Silker and husband Vernon Silker as a gift.

June 6th 1986 Merlin passes away

July 20th 1992 Robert Silker and Karen Olson have a son named Brandon Tyler Silker

May 1st 1996 Robert Silker buys 3 acres of land where the farm buildings stand for use of a shop to restore muscle cars. Purchase price was \$1 and was said to be a gift of his inheritance that his grandfather would have wanted him to have.

October 29th 1996 Beatrice Dorsey Passes away.

Vern Silker passes away on February 23rd 1998, Just shortly before the opening of his son's Robert Silker new industrial painting business, Largest of its kind in southern Minnesota.

On August 4th 2015 Betty Jean Dorsey Silker passes away and leaves the family farm to her grandson Brandon Tyler Silker. Brandon will be the youngest to inherit the farm and its rich history at age 23. Conditions are that his Father Robert Silker be allowed a life lease and allowed to run the farm as long as he is able. Total tillable acres today is 71.87 acres principle crops are beans and corn on a rotation basis. Total acres are 87.1 Only stipulation is that he can never borrow money against it!

We are celebrating our 158th year this year. Everything here is based off 1858 records.

Charles Grobe, one of the self-made men of Wabasha County, who from an humble beginning, has by long continued industry attained affluence, and is now one of the leading citizens of West Albany Township, residing on a farm in section 17, was born in Hanover, Germany, January 24, 1863. His parents were August and Johanna (Weidenmeier) Grobe, the father being a small farmer. In his boyhood Charles Grobe attended common school up to the age of 14 years. At 15 he began to learn the shoemaker's trade and worked at it subsequently for five years. In 1883, at the age of 20, he came to America and prolonging his westward journey to Minnesota, finally arrived in West Albany Township, this county, where he had an uncle. He at once became connected with the agricultural industry, finding employment as a farm hand with William Heinz, for whom he worked four years, and later with Joseph Benz, in whose employ he remained six years. During those ten years of steady work he never lost a day, and the money he earned, except what he paid out for necessities, was carefully saved to form a basis of capital for future independent operations. At last the time came when he felt able to branch out on his own account, and in order to do so more effectually, he wisely resolved to take a partner, for better or for worse, in the strenuous pursuit of fortune. Lovedirected his choice, and on September 26, 1892, he was united in marriage with Eda Bertha Frank, daughter of Charles and Julia Frank, of West Albany. She was born in Germany, January 17, 1874, and came to America at the age of 18 years with her brother Theodore, her father and another brother, Charles, having preceded them to this country. Mr. and Mrs. Grobe began home making on a farm belonging to Joseph Benz, in section 17, West Albany Township, which they rented for five years. Economy was carefully practiced by the young couple and both worked hard and, as a result, made progress. In 1897 Mr. Grobe bought the Richard Hammond farm of 160 acres in section 8, West Albany, and he and his wife moved onto it. There was a fair set of buildings and 145 acres of the land had been broken. Mr. Grobe grubbed twelve acres, remodeled the house, built a frame barn, 36 by 76 by 14 feet, with full basement of 9 feet, and a machine shed, besides making other improvements from time to time, as they were needed. On that farm he resided with his family for 20 years, the end of that period finding him well advanced on the road to prosperity. He was already the owner of his present place in section 17, having purchased it of Joseph Benz in 1902. It was only half a mile south of where

he was then living, and was a farm of 297 acres, with 200 under the plow, and with a fair set of buildings. On moving to it in 1917, he leased the Hammond farm to his son William, and his main efforts both since then and previously, have been to develop the larger property. This he has done very effectually, having remodeled the house, now a modern, nine-room, two-story frame structure; built a frame barn, 36 by 80 by 14 feet, with full basement of 8 feet, cement floors, steel stanchions, and running water; and also put up granaries, machine sheds, and a steel windmill, with the result of making it one of the finest and best equipped farms in this locality. In addition to this, he owns and operates a large threshing outfit, and is the owner of a 300-acre farm near Millville, in Oakwood Township. This latter farm, 160 acres of which are under the plow, and which has a fair set of buildings, he rents out to a tenant. Since selling 160 acres to his son William, he has bought another 160-acre tract near Jacksonville, known as the Christ Hyde farm. On his own place Mr. Grobe is engaged in diversified farming, keeping good stock, his cattle, of the Shorthorn variety, numbering from 60 to 70 head. He has led a regular life, has shunned the saloon, and refrained even from tobacco, conserving his energies for the main duties of life, and in their full and exact performance has found no need for either stimulants or narcotics. He and his family are members of the West Albany congregation of the German M. E. church, of which he is a trustee. Throughout the 27 years of their married life he and his wife have worked together, and are now enjoying the results of the mutual labors. They have a high standing in the community, and have brought up their children in habits of industry, morality and religious observance. These children are as follows: William Carl, born September 15, 1893, who operates one of his father's farms, on rental which he bought in 1920, was married November 10, 1917, to Ella Fick, daughter of William and Christina Fick. He has one child, Ruth, born August 13, 1918. Vanda Alfrida, born February 2, 1896, as yet unmarried, is a trained nurse. She graduated from the Dorcas Institute at Cincinnati, then entered the Berthesda Hospital where she remained eleven months, and on account of sickness returned to her home, remaining nine months, then entered the Lake City Hospital, remaining there one and a half years; then entered the Minneapolis General Hospital where she graduated June 2, 1920. Charles John, born February 26, 1899, and Alfred Gothard, born July 15, 1903, are associated with their father in agricultural work. Florence Julia and Frances Johanna (twins), born August 22, 1904, are attending school.

Henry Ahrens, along with his parents Johann and Louisa and siblings William, John, Richard and Herman emigrated to the United States in about 1885 from Hanover, Germany. The family first settled in Mitchell County Iowa near Osage. Henry Ahrens, Richard's Grandfather, married a woman from Hart, Minnesota. Henry and Lena lived in Osage for a while before moving to Hart and then to the farm property in Lewiston in 1916. Remnant implements from Grandpa Henry's era still grace the farm. They include a surrey from he and Lena's wedding, a John Deere horse-drawn two-bottom plow, a wooden Rumley Ideal Jr. threshing machine and a hand cranked corn sheller. Grandpa tamed wild horses to work the land. The family ordered household goods, furniture and machinery delivered by rail. Grandpa Henry sold his milk to the New Lewiston Creamery. We still have a capital stock certificate for seven(\$5) shares. You would probably describe theirs as a diversified farming operation with dairy, hogs, chicken, horses, hay corn, oats and barley. Henry and Lena had four children. The first died in infancy and then came daughters Clara, Cora and son Erwin, Richard's Father. Their lives were impacted by the Great Depression, but they persevered through lean times and plenty.

As Erwin matured, he assumed helm of the farm. He and his wife Elsie appreciated the prime farmland, worked together to farm, and raised their three children: Anita, Judy and Richard. Elsie tended enviable vegetable gardens to feed the family and flower gardens to beautify the farm. During their farming years. Erwin built another barn and switched from dairy to beef cattle. shipped beef calves in by rail, herding them down Lewiston's Main Street. He shipped his fat cattle to St. Paul stockyards where his cattle topped the weekly market many times. In 1933, Highway 14 divided the farmyard from the fields, causing quite an inconvenience. One of the many adventures in their farming days included raising five acres of cucumbers for the Lewiston Pickle Factory. Can you imagine stooping to pick a field of cucumbers? Another story told of a biplane that landed on the 7 acres just west of the grove before Highway 14 and the power lines. We often heard the story of Erwin buying the first tractor, a Waterloo Boy, much to Henry's chagrin. Henry favored Jack and Molly, his trusted team. Erwin and Elsie were as self-sufficient as possible, depending on a strong work ethic to see them through. The couple bought some additional farmland, including a parcel north of Altura. Erwin and Richard added 2 pole barns to the Lewiston farm – a loafing shed and machine shed. The two men shared a love of music. Erwin played violin and accordion while Richard played guitar and mandolin. They played for their own enjoyment and for the public.

Richard assumed the reins of the farming operation then. He and wife Karen raised children Emily, Paula and Timothy in a house nearby the farm. Richard took on a bit more farmland and bought a one-room country schoolhouse built by Luxembourg immigrants bordering the farm north of Altura. Richard is passionate about historic preservation. He built and equipped a working Blacksmith Shop and rescued the Schuster Dorn Harness and Shoe Shop. Both have a prominent place in the farmyard. Richard's family, along with Elsie, often demonstrated pioneer skills and gave tours of the farm to schoolchildren. Richard restored a trailer load of hit and miss engines for exhibit. He and Karen raised beef cattle and cash crops. After Elsie's death in 2008, Richard and Karen moved into the farmhouse. They have made every effort to restore the house, maintaining its character while making it more energy efficient. The children have grown with families of their own. Timothy helps his parents manage the farmland. The farm is Certified Organic.
