





arles Ljungren, Sebeka, has been these last few months building farms. These farms are replicated of the Ljungren farm today and farm in 1921 when Charles' als first purchased it.

parles began his project last ary by measuring buildings and oximating the height of trees.

1921 replica took a bit of the using old photos of the farm.

1831 a scale (1/8" = 1 foot)

1842 constructed each building and the two model farms were lete.

original 1921 farm shows the as it was, an antique saw rig, seled and a horse and cart with trees and fences intact.

Present replica is much larger, displaying each building as land today. All flowers, shrubs, are accounted for in exact

numbers. Rock gardens surrounding the home resemble the originals. Charles' wife Esther's garden is shown complete with the raspberries on the raspberry bushes. The wagons and easy flows are filled with real oats as if ready to be used. Clotheslines, birdhouses and fuel barrels are not forgotten in the project, and fences and gates are in position.

In the 1920's, electrical lines were not used but the present model shows their exact location.

Charles used wood for the entire project, excluding the animals and vehicles which are purchased and then painted to match the original.

The hardest thing was to make the trees look real. Explains Charles, "Only God can make trees." He turned the trees on a wood lathe.

To make the grass, Charles first painted the wood the farm sits on, then decided to mix sawdust with the paint to add texture and make the grass more realistic. He glued sand to create the drives that run through the farm. Everything is glued in place to make it possible to display the replica farms or hang them up.

Charles began working with wood ten to fifteen years ago. Once he mastered the building of different items like mosquito houses, candle holders, and wooden games, he decided to try something more difficult.

After selling most of his dairy cattle, Charles found more time to work on projects like the replica farms.

The three-month project turned out to be quite a success. Charles now plans to begin another model of the farm to add to his collection and bring another part of the past to life. The new model will be a replica of the farm as it was in 1957, when Charles and Esther bought it from his parents.

In addition to farming, Henry F. Dobberstein was one of Buffalo Lake's outstanding community leaders. He was active in many civic and church affairs, having served on the Buffalo Lake School Board (25+ years); as Zion Lutheran Church's Sunday School Superintendent (20+ years), as well as being active on the board of directors of both the Farmers Elevator and the Co-Op Creamery. As First District County Commissioner, Henry served two terms. He was a Veterans' Service Officer and on the Community Clinic and Nursing Home Boards. During World War II, Henry was Chairman of the Ration Board and served as Commander of the Legion Post.

Like father, like son! Lea S. Dobberstein was also one of Buffalo Lake's outstanding community leaders. Over his lifetime, he served in different capacities in many organizations including the Renville County Health Services Foundation, Buffalo Lake Nursing Home Board (20 years), Commander of American Legion Post 469 (33 years), Preston Lake Town Board, Buffalo Lake Lions Club, Buffalo Lake School Board, Renville County Commissioner (1992 – 1996), Buffalo Lake Onwards 4-H Club, and Southwest Initiative Foundation. Later in life, Lea added the title of Insurance Agent to his daily activities.

A more thorough "Dobberstein Farms" succession is as follows:

Original Family Owner: Henry F. Dobberstein Henry F. Dobberstein purchased eighty acres defined as the west half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section thirty-two (32), Township one hundred fifteen (115), Range thirty-one (31) in 1919 from John and Wilma Gilbertson at a cost of \$160.00 per acre. A prominent and progressive farmer, Henry purchased an additional eighty acres defined as the south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section thirty-two (32), Township one hundred fifteen (115), Range thirty-one (31) in 1945 from the state of Minnesota at a cost of fifty dollars per acre. This land had been forfeited by its previous owners for taxes.

Next Owner: Lea S. Dobberstein / Henry F. and Ida E. Dobberstein Henry Dobberstein sold half of his land (80 acres) to his son Lea in 1966 via a contract for deed. These eighty (80) acres are defined as the west half (W ½) of the southwest quarter (SW ¼), Section thirty-two (32), Township one hundred fifteen (115), Range thirty-one (31). The other half of the land (80 acres) remained in Henry and Ida's name until Henry died.

Next Owner: Lea S. Dobberstein / Ida E. Dobberstein Upon Henry's death, Ida became the sole owner of "the north eighty" defined as the south half (S ½) of the northwest quarter (NW ¼), Section thirty-two (32), Township one hundred fifteen (115), Range thirty-one (31).

Next Owner: Lea S. Dobberstein Upon Ida's death (1988), Lea became the sole owner of the original homestead acreage as well as the eighty acres Henry acquired in 1945. Over the years, Lea S. Dobberstein enlarged farming operations to include more than six hundred acres.

Next (and Current) Owner: Meridee D. Dobberstein Upon Lea's death (2013), Meridee D. Dobberstein became the sole owner of "Dobberstein Farms."
