Mille Lacs County - Additional comments:

In 1928, Helmut Totzke (2nd generation) was putting hay in the barn and driving horses for the hay fork when the rope was caught, breaking the eveners. One piece struck him in the stomach. He died of internal injuries at the age of 33 years from the accident.

Marie (Totzke) & Alfred Anderson (3rd generation) raised their 4 children on the farm following Helmut's death. When Dewey & Iris Anderson (4th generation) were married, Marie & Alfred moved to a farm next door where they continued to milk cows and farm.


Following Dewey & Iris's marriage, Dewey was called to serve our country in the Army. Iris with help from her in-laws, Alfred & Marie Anderson tended to calves & heifers so when Dewey concluded his military service in 1956 he could resume milking cows and the couple would have an income.


Dewey & Iris Anderson raised their family of 4 children on the self-sustaining farm. Dairy (Holstein animals) and swine were the main forms of income.

Nieces and nephews of Dewey & Iris would enjoy spending time at the farm in the summer. The family also hosted Exchange Students through the 4-H Program.

The barn was straightened in 2006 using block & tackle in the hay mow. Buildings have been maintained to retain the original structure & character as much as possible.

The farm was homesteaded by George Aasl, Feb. 13, 1878, R.B. Hayes, President of the U.S. Mr. Aasl sold to Jonas Doerr for \$1200.00 or \$7.50 an acre, on June 24, 1881. Doerr sold to Gottlieb Quast on August, 22, 1887, for \$4000.00 or \$25.00 an acre.

The first family owner, Gottlieb Quast was born in Eichberg, Kreis Filehne, Posen Province, Prussia, March 15, 1844. He arrived in the U.S. with his parents and 6(?) siblings when he was 16. Julianne *Huebner* Quast was born in Prussia August 21, 1849. Her name is variously spelled "Julie" and "Julia" on the land documents.

NELSOW FAMILY FARM NARRATIVE

THE NELSON FAMILY NAME, HAS REMAINIFD AS GWNERS, FOR OVER 100 CONTINUOUS YEARS. THE ACREAGE IS MIMOST ENTERFLY IN AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION WITH THE EXCEPTIONS OF FARM BUDDINGS AND A SMALL PARCEL OF WELDLIFE GRASSLAND.

OUR GRAND FATTHER, NELS NELSON, IMMIGRATED FROM SWEDEN IN THE 1870'S. THE FAMOLY ENETTALLY CAME TO VASA, MN., NEAR RED WENG. WHERE THEY LOVED FOR SEVEN (7) YEARS. THE FAMILY DELIVED THEFR MOVE TO TRAVERSE COUNTY UNTIL NELS WAS CONFERMED FOR THE VASA LUTHCRAN CHURCH, BY EREC NORELEUS, THE FOUNDER OF GUSTAVAS ADDUPHUS COLLEGE. THE NELSON FAMILY HAD AN OPPORTUNITY TO ASSEST A BACHELOR FARMER IN WALLS TOWNSHEP, TRAVERSE COUNTY. IT WAS NEAR THES LOCATION THAT IT YEAR OLD NELS, WAS AN EYEWITNESS TO THE HEFTORICAL TRAVERSE DE SIOUX LAWD RUSH IN 1892. IT WAS SOMEWANT OF A HARDSHEP LANGUE 14 MELES FROM THE NEAREST TOWN, WHENTON. HENCE, THEY SOLD AND PURCHASED THE WEST LAKE VALLEY TOWNSHIP QUARTER OF LAND WHICH WAS ONLY 42 MILLES FROM WHEATON.

OUR NELSON FAMELY EXPERTENCED A LIFE CHANGING TRACEDY IN 1960, WHEN BROTHER, STUART, 14 YEARS OF AGE; WAS ELECTROCUTED IN A FARM ACCEPPENT. WITH THE WEIGHT OF UNRESOLVED GRIEF, OUR FATHER, TED, AND HIS WIFE, MARRE, MOVED TO THE CITY IN 1965. THE FARM LAND HAS BEEN (CONTINUED)

RENTED OUT CONTINUOUSLY, EVER STWCE.

OUR GRANDPARENTS; NELS AND ANNA, AND PARENTS; TED AND MARTE,

THEY COULD BE. IN ADDITION TO AGRICULTURAL CROP PRODUCTION,
THEY CARED FOR FARM ANIMALS SUCH AS DALRY COWS, FEEDER CATTLE,
HOGS, AND CHICKENS. THIS MADE FOR LONG WORK DAYS, TWENTY
FOUR SEVEN (2417). DON, STUART, AND I CLYNN) ALSO CONTROBUTED
TO FARM WORK DURING CHILDHOOD AND ADOLESCENCE.

WE RESTECT THE LEGACY AND UNENDFUL WORK ETHIC OF OUR FOREFATHERS, AND APPRECIATE THE SACRIFICES THEY MADE FOR BETTERMENT OF FAMBLY. THEY WERE AGLE TO FINANCIALLY SURVICE THE GREAT DEPRESSION WITHOUT LOSING THE LAND, THROUGH HARD WORK AND GOOD MANAGEMENT, FOR WHICH WE ARE GRATEFUL.

Sam & Nellie Zellweger moved from the rolling hills of southern lowa, at the same time that other families moved to the
flat lands of southern Waseca County. Families included Recknor's, Volling's, Root's and possibly others. The men
moved their livestock first, by train. The families followed, also by train. Families celebrated Thanksgivings together.

In the summer of 1917 and during the World War, a land boom was on and rent was so high that some of the young married people of southern Iowa set out to find cheaper but just as good land as their homeland on which to make a living for their families. After looking at Montana and other places, four families settled in the vicinity of New Richland, Minnesota in the spring of 1918. Mr. and Mrs. Orvin Brown and their two children, Vaughn, age 6 years, and Maxine, 1 year old; Mr. and Mrs. Ernest Recknor and two children, Viroqua, age 5 years, and Lester, 1 year old; Mr. and Mrs. Sam Zellweger and four daughters, Gladys, age 7, Lavena, age 5, Opal, age 2, and Theora, 7 months; Mr. and Mrs. August Volling and three children, Lloyd, 9 years old, Kenneth, 6 years old, and Hylis, just a few weeks old. John Eligeneer also came as a hired man for Orvin Brown. During that summer he was drafted into the army and saw service overseas, but after the war came back to Minnesota and worked for several different men in District #49 until he finally married the school teacher, Nettie Ryberg of Kasota, where they then made their home until he died in the Veteran's Hosptial at Fort Snelling. He left his widow and two sons.

The Iowa group continued meeting until about 1981 with only William O'Riley family descendants and the John Bunn family descendants attending.

The earliest records we have is the meeting in 1931 when they met at the John Bunn home. Mrs. Bessie Recknor was elected president and Mrs. Meryl Molyneux was vice president. In August of that year a picnic was held at Clear Lake, a large number from Waseca attending.

Thanksgiving in 1933 was held at the Arnie Routh home with sixteen families present and six families absent. On July 12, 1933, the Iowa group met at Beaver Lake for a surprise picnic honoring Ada and John Bunn for their twenty-fifth wedding anniversary.

In 1934 the annual event was held at the William O'Riley home with twelve families present. Orvin Brown passed away December 17, 1934. Ara Brown passed away August 14, 1935.

On a cold blustery Thanksgiving Day in 1935 the group met at the Delbert Hannon home with six families present.

The Thanksgiving get together in 1936 was held at the John Bunn home. Ten families attended.

The 1937 meeting was held at the Pat Molyneux home. Ninety-four people attended. This was almost perfect attendance. Seven new families were added to the roll. They were:

The 1938 get together was held at the home of Mark Miller. A total of seventy-nine attended the feast.

In 1939 the group met at the Ernest Recknor home. In 1940 the group was at the Arnie Routh home. Blessings were really counted that year as the group met so soon after the November 11th storm. Many left their cars on the road and were taxied in by the Rouths. Twelve families attended.

A picnic was held that August in Owatonna honoring Mr. and Mrs. Clifford Buxton and Mr. and Mrs. George Looney.

On November 20, 1941, the William O'Riley home was the scene of the annual Thanksgiving gathering. Everyone was thankful to have Irene Root among them as she had spent a period during the summer and five weeks in the fall in the hospital. Irene was presented a floral bouquet by Ada Bunn from the group. Twenty-one families attended. The food, as always, was plentiful and delicious. Rev. Pobanz made a motion for a glass of Alka Seltzer with many more seconding the motion. On December 7, 1941, many took their filled baskets to the Pat Molyneux home honoring them and Mr. and Mrs. A.J. Skelton on their silver wedding anniversary.

The November 26, 1942 annual Thanksgiving gathering was held in the Community Hall at Waseca. There were six hostesses and hosts that paid \$5.00 for the use of the hall. Thirteen families attended. Lester Recknors and Kenneth O'Rileys were accepted as new members.

The November 25, 1943 annual Thanksgiving dinner was held at the I.O.O.F. Hall in New Richland. Eighteen families attended. Mr. and Mrs. Floyd Sawyer and Mr. and Mrs. Melvin Demmer were taken in as new members. Enoch Root gave us the hair raising story of his surprise bear trip hunting experience.

The 1944 meeting was held at the John Bunn home near Ellendale. Twenty-three families attended. Although the tragedies of war was deep in our families minds and many loved ones of our families were far from home, everyone had many things to be thankful for. Despite rationing and a few hard to get food items, a very delicious and bountiful table was filled from the baskets of all present and Ada's kitchen. Through the thoughtfulness of Mrs. Enoch Root, Grandma Daniels was presented with lovely flowers by Pat Molyneux on behalf of the Iowa group. The subject of having yearly dues was brought up and discussed and it was decided that each family pay twenty-five cents. New families were added to the group, Merrill Eckler, Jerry Mickelson, Luther Paulson and Rex Volling. Lester Root entertained with several songs accompanied by Leta Root at the piano.

On November 22, 1945, the Iowa group gathered at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Delbert Hannon near Morristown. Thirteen families attended even though there was a regular winter snowstorm. This being our first peace time Thanksgiving for some time, it seemed everyone was a little happier and really thankful. The dues were then raised to fifty cents for each family. It was decided to revise the membership and put those who had not attended for four or five years on an Honorary List so they would not have to pay dues. When it was learned that the program committee had forgotten their job, Leta Root took over and in a short time had a very nice program organized.

In 1946, twenty-one families were heartily welcomed at the Ernest and Bessie Recknor home. During the business meeting there was an election of officers. The officers gave it the term of railroading. A motion was made that a new book be purchased for the minutes and records. It was decided that it would be nice for each family to write up a short history to be kept in the records. The only one found in the book was the Bunn family history. Grandma Daniels, Ada Bunn's mother, passed away November 30, 1946.

The annual Thanksgiving dinner of 1947 was held at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Will Skelton north of Owatonna. Eleven families attended covering quite a distance under rather difficult driving conditions. A motion was made that fifty cents be allowed to buy a fiber brief case to keep the record books in. Mr. Florence Eckler suggested we have a penny march to swell our treasurer's fund. This practice was continued during the rest of the years of the annual meeting. A tradition was also started to sing, "The More We Get Together" during the penny march.

In 1948 the Iowa get together was held at the Sam and Nellie Zellweger home with thirteen families present. There were eighteen of the first generation, sixteen of the second generation and twelve of the third generation.

In November of 1949 the Thanksgiving dinner was held at the home of Mrs. Bill O'Riley. Eighteen families were present.

In 1950 the gang was found at the Enoch Root home. Thanksgiving Day was the coldest day they had had that fall. The temperature registered from -10° to -15° below zero. Many cars had to be started during the day to keep them from freezing. The group decided to suspend dues for 1950 as they had money on hand. However, the penny march was made in honor of Florence Eckler who had suggested it. A motion was made that Lawrence Clemons be added to the roll call.

The Thanksgiving home coming of the Iowa group gathered at the John Bunn home in November 1951. Eighteen families were present. The day was chilly and a light snow fell during the day. New members welcomed to the group were Ed Ciesielski, Gus Garlishes and Lowell Root.

The postponed Thanksgiving dinner of the "Iowa Bunch" was held at the Delbert Hannon home on December 7th, 1952. A severe snow storm blocking roads and snarling traffic in general came on November 25th, two days before Thanksgiving, so the get together had to be postponed until December 7th. Twelve families attended. I believe this was the only year that it had to be postponed. Darkness, as usual, made everyone present realize another wonderful day had passed all too quickly and the warm friendly feeling of having spent a day with friends of long standing left a glow in our hearts as we made our way to our own homes. (End quote.)

The 1953 meeting was held at the Ernest Recknor home. The penny march produced \$4.15 for our treasury.

The 1954 annual Thanksgiving dinner of the Iowa group was held at the home of Leona and Ed Ciesielski. The day was cold and snowy but fourteen families were present. New members accepted into the group were Lester, Lyle and Lyndall Root.

In 1955 eighteen families gathered at the home an Sam and Nellie Zellweger for the Iowa group Thanksgiving dinner. The day was cold. As part of the program that day Ernest Recknor and John Bunn exchanged a few "seed corn" stories.

Thanksgiving Day of 1956 found twelve families present to enjoy dinner together at the Enock Root home. Dean and Dorothy Irhke were added as new members to the group. The penny march added \$4.00 to the treasury.

Mr. and Mrs. Henry Paulson were host and hostess for the annual Iowa
Thanksgiving Day get to gether. Twelve families were represented. The group
was entertained by "I've Got A Secret" panel. Bill Cullen was portrayed by
Lester Root, Jayne Meadows by Leona Ciesielski, Henry Morgan by Lowell Root and
Faye Emerson by Kathryn Bunn. Grandma O'Riley's secret was that she and Ada Bunn and
their children had come by train together from Iowa to Minnesota. Their husbands
had come by two immigrant cars ahead of the women, arriving only one day before
the women. Irene Root's secret was that as a young girl they used to hitch a
cow to a buggy to go riding.

The 1958 Iowa Thanksgiving dinner was held at the home of Leta and Lawrence Clemons. Fourteen families were present. Merrill Bunn and his wife, Bea, were added as members of our gang.

The 1959 Iowa group motored to Austin to the John, Ada and Kathryn Bunn home for their annual Thanksgiving dinner. Eleven families made the journey to Austin.

This little history has been compiled from twenty-seven years of records kept by various secretaries of the group. 1959 is the last date of information recorded in the book.

They left Gothenburg Sweden on June 6, 1869 with four children, (Ida, Charles, Oskar and Hilda), arrived in New York, New York July 18, 1869. Arrived in Otisco Township, Section 2 later that same year. At that time there was a body of water bordering the farm known as Canfield Lake, hence the designation of "Lakeside" in Gustof's name. Canfield lake is no longer in existence.
