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The Dehl farm in Treeborn County became a Century farm in 1955. Its irst ancestor, Many Telson, came from Morway. She lost her husband and son at sea. She met Anfind Anderson who lived in New York, and drove a cab (with horses) to meet the boats. They were married around 1853, loved in Wisconsin a short time, then moved to Minnesota. They lived in a sod house and homesteeded the land purchased from the U.S. government in 1855. Indians were still present in the area. Anfind fought during the Civil War. A log house, one of the first in Preeborn County was built around 1860. Ohurch services and Sunday School were held here. Upon the death of Anfind, his son Joseph took over the farm. Mary died way 9,1906. Phone service was established that year.

In 1906, Joseph Anderson sold the farm to his sister Petsy and her husband, Christopher S. Dahl, who came from Norway in 1873. Betsy was baptized, confirmed and married in the log house. Christ and Petsy were married December 7, 1878 and had sixteen children, nine boys(Severt, Eddie, Theodore, Carl, Alvin, Rudolph, Harry, Alfred, Norman) and seven girls, (Emma, Mary, Lillie, Esther, Abbie, Pearl, Manda). The farm was paid for 1921. Christ died in 1936 at age 82, and Betsy died in 1939 at age 78. The farm was one of the first to receive electricity in 1937.

In 1944, Alvin Dahl (son of Betsy and Christ) and his wife Vivian (Overgaard) bought the farm from the estate and farmed until 1959, when Alvin passed away at age 62. They had eight children, three died in infancy. Those surviving are Paul, Gloria, Alton, Poger, Carolyn. Vivian Dahl died in 1984 at age 87.

In 1961 the farm was purchased by Paul Dahl and his wife Jeanine (Allen) The log house was replaced in 1964, but part of it remains on the farm. Paul and Jeanine have three son, Thomas, Barry and Jerry. Thomas is married to Ponnie (Nelson), they have two children, Anthony and Angela. Barry is erry is married to Mathy (Krebs), they have three children, Wesley, David and Preston.

The farm was a dairy farm until 1976 and now is a hog operation run by Thomas and Parry. The original farm was 160 acres. Now it is 350 acres with corn and soybeans being raised.

WILLIAM A. CARMODY is a native of Ireland, and was born in the year 1829. He came to America in 1851, and after spending one year each in Ohio and Kentucky, came to Minnesota. He remained in St. Anthony two years, being employed in the erection of the suspension bridge, and also lumbering and farming. In 1855, he came to Princeton and selected his present farm on section thirty-two, where he erected a house and moved the following year. Mr. Carmody has a fine farm of three hundred and sixty acres.

Edward W. Cater is a son of Martin V. B. Cater, and was born in Barrington, New Hampshire, in 1855. When he was two years old the family removed to Minnesota, and with the exception of two years at school in Minneapolis, resided at home until 1875, when he bought a farm of three hundred and twenty acres, located on sections twenty-three and twenty-four, where he now lives.

George W. Dunton dates his birth in Oldtown, Maine, on the 25th of February, 1830. In early life he learned the trade of brick-mason, and was servards engaged in the manufacture of lime and brick. Returning to St. Louis, he entered the office of the "Missouri State Atlas," with the intention of learning the printer's trade, for which he had long cherished a desire. After the campaign of 1872, the "Atlas" suspended, and Robert entered the office of the "Industrial Age," and later, the "Journal" office, where he finished his apprenticeship. He continued his journalistic labors there until January, 1876, when he was prostrated by partial paralysis, and suffered severely for four months. For the benefit of his health he came to Minnesota, where he soon partially recovered, and on the 30th of December, by the kind assistance of friends, he issued the first number of the "Princeton Union." He was then less than twenty-two years old, and probably the youngest editor in the State. Since then the "Union" has steadily increased in popularity, and under his management, has attained an extensive circulation in Mille Lacs and the adjoining counties of Sherburne and Isanti, and will compare favorably with any country newspaper in the State. Mr. Dunn is well liked by the people of Princeton, irrespective of party, and his paper is noted for its political independence, although the editor is a republican.

ALBERT B. DAMON, the oldest living settler of Mille Lacs county, was born in Troy, Maine, on the 4th of June, 1824. He came to Minnesota in 1852, and after remaining one winter about five miles north of the present city of Minneapolis, came to Princeton, and made the first claim on the site of the present village. "Banjo Bill" and one or two others had been here before, but did not make claims. The former had built the first shanty, and Mr. Damon built the second, a log house which still stands in the rear of the North Star House. There was no settler nearer Mr. Damon than Elk River, on the Mississippi. In 1855, he sold his claim to Samuel Ress, and selected the quarter section adprinciples first claim on the south, a portion of which he has since surveyed and platted, and is now known as Damon's addition to Princeton. In 1862, Mr. Damon enlisted in the Eighth Minnesots Volunteer Infantry, and served three years. On returning from the army he settled in section eighteen, Baldwin township, Sherburne county,
