John Peter Bach I was born in the Alsace region of France in 1828. As a youngster, he immigrated to New York state with his parents, Petro and Anna. In 1867, at the age of 39, John Peter Bach I took his mother Anna age 78, his wife Elizabeth age 33, and their three daughters, Victoria age 4, Louise age 2 and newborn Felicitas to Minnesota. His father Petro, an infant son and an infant daughter had all died in New York. John Peter I purchased a 160 acre homestead farm in Danville Township on November 8, 1867, with Indians and bandits still in the area. The farm has been in the Bach name and occupied by the Bach family ever since. John Peter I's mother Anna died shortly after arriving in Minnesota. Through the years, five more children were born, including John Peter II. The present 2-story home was built in the 1890s by John Peter I and multiple generations have lived their entire lives here, most notably, John Peter II's son, Roman Bach who died 60 days short of age 100 in 2017. The four sons of Gerard John and Julie Ann Bach are next in line to live here, namely, Jerad John, Joseph William, Andrew Roman, and Alex John Bach.


Enclosed is a Sesquicentennial Farm Application.

In 1881, he married his housekeeper, also a Norwegian immigrant, and began a family who were taught the values of hard work and preservation of the family farm. Kittel's youngest son Carl took over the farm. He was a WWI veteran and had an untimely death in 1940, leaving a widow and eight children. The next year, my grandmother became chronically ill and was unable to care for her family. After his father's death, my father had taken over operation of the family farm. Upon his mother's illness, he also assumed the responsibility of raising his seven younger siblings, all of this by the age of 15. Despite these numerous challenges, he remained in high school, completing the 12th grade and graduating salutatorian in 1943. The same year, he received the Minnesota FFA's Star Farmer Award. His siblings all graduated from high school and either served our country in the military and/or recieved higher educations. In 1970, he married Elizabeth Wakefield. They continued to operate the farm while making their home there and having two daughters who continue to own this farm. The younger daughter, Rachel, and her husband Martin currently reside on the farmstead.



Additional comments: The great-great grandson of Patrick and Bridget Hennessy currently resides in the house.

Someone else rents the cropland. An additional 138 acres was purchased in 1991. The farm now totals 258 acres of which about 110 acres are cropland and about 148 acres are woodland and grassland.

The farm is located on County road 25, 3 1/2 miles southwest of Wyattville, just before going down into Rush Creek Valley. Many of the settlers in this area on the ridge above Rush Creek were Irish. The Norwegians came up Rush Creek from Rushford and settled in Rush Creek Valley which they called Hardanger Dalen after the area of Norway from where many of them had came.

Patrick Hennessy came from Ireland to Memphis, Tennessee and in the early 1860's came to Minnesota. In 1904 Patrick Hennessy sold the farm to his son, John Hennessy. Patrick and Bridget Hennessy then moved and purchased a farm in Avoca, Minnesota. Both Patrick and Bridget are buried in St. Rose of Lima Cemetery, Avoca, Minnesota Bernard and Anna Hennessy purchased the farm from his father, John Hennessy in 1940. Bernard had lived on the farm his entire lifetime and after his death, Bernard J. Hennessy & Jerry Hennessy purchased the farm in 1988.
