Minnesota Uniform Crime Report Summary January - December, 1995-1996

The index crimes (or Part 1 crimes) (murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson) reported during January-December, 1996, increased 1.7% from 206,710 in 1995 to 210,246 in 1996. Rural areas recorded a decrease of 2.1% and urban areas a 2.3% increase. Minneapolis had a 1.0% decrease and St. Paul recorded a 2.0% increase.

Violent crimes (murder, rape, robbery and aggravated assault) decreased 2.9% from 16,319 in 1995 to 15,839 in 1996.

Property crimes (burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson) increased 2.1% from 190,391 in 1995 to 194,407 in 1996.
