Minnesota Uniform Crime Report Summary January - December, 1998-1999

Following are the statistics for the **1999 Minnesota Uniform Crime Report**. The percentages presented should be viewed with the understanding that during 1999 many law enforcement agencies were in the process of updating their reporting systems to accommodate Year 2000 changes. While our normal deadline for year-end statistics was February 10, 2000, we extended it until March 10th to assist agencies having difficulty. This proved to be beneficial to many departments. However, we have identified a few agencies that were unable to transmit all of their 1999 data by the March 10th deadline.

The figures provided are based on actual entries into the Minnesota Criminal Justice Reporting System.

Minnesota Uniform Crime Report Summary January - December, 1998-1999

The index crimes (or Part 1 crimes) (murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson) reported during January-December, 1999, decreased 11% from 192,924 in 1998 to 171,376 in 1999. Rural areas recorded a decrease of 11% and Urban areas an 11% decrease. Minneapolis had an 11% decrease and St. Paul recorded a 10% decrease and Duluth a 10% decrease.

Violent crimes (murder, rape, robbery and aggravated assault) decreased 10% from 14,855 in 1998 to 13,252 in 1999.

Property crimes (burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson) decreased 11% from 178,069 in 1998 to 158,124 in 1999.
