Minnesota Uniform Crime Report Summary January - December, 2002-2003

The index crimes (or Part 1 crimes) (murder, rape, robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson) reported during January-December, 2003, decreased 2.5% from 177,219 in 2002 to 172,666 in 2003. Rural areas recorded an increase of 4.1% and Urban areas a 3.6% decrease. Minneapolis had a 6.3% decrease and St. Paul recorded a 10% decrease and Duluth a 4.3% decrease.

Violent crimes (murder, rape, robbery and aggravated assault) increased 4.2% from 13,054 in 2002 to 13,627 in 2003.

Property crimes (burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson) decreased 3.1% from 164,165 in 2002 to 159,039 in 2003.
