RTB Holds Public Hearings on Five-Year Transit Plan

St. Paul, June 20, 1989--The Regional Transit Board (RTB) will hold a public hearing on its proposed Five-Year Transit Plan, legislatively known as the Implementation Plan, on Monday, July 10, 1989 at 5:30 p.m. in the Board Chambers of Mears Park Centre, 230 E. Fifth Street, St. Paul. Additional public comments will be heard during a second public hearing to be held on Monday, July 24, 1989 at 4:00 p.m. in Room A of Mears Park Centre. The draft Five-Year Transit Plan may be obtained or examined at the RTB offices on the Seventh Floor of Mears Park Centre.

The Five-Year Implementation Plan establishes the direction, priorities and timing for various elements which make up the metropolitan transit system. It will provide overall direction for metropolitan transit services for the next five years.

The development of the plan was a community effort in that the RTB met with several groups to get their input about the plan. Through these meetings, the RTB was able to incorporate a wide range of ideas into the plan. The community is encouraged to attend and bring comment to the public hearings.

The RTB is a planning and policy making board established by the Legislature in 1984 to serve as a short to mid-range planning agency. Recently reorganized, the RTB will consist of elected officials and those with management experience. The new RTB Board, appointed by the Metropolitan Council, should be in place in August.
