





Re: Marie Thielen - age 27

Earlier today we receive a telephone call from Dr. John B. Beuning who requested that we see Marie Thielen on an emergency basis because of her peculiar behavior. Apparently this young woman's mother, Mrs. Henry Thielen and her sister, Mrs. Magnus Konz felt that she was becoming unmanageable. In response to Dr. Beuning's request, I interviewed the relatives and Dr. Clampitt was able to interview the patient only briefly as she sat in an automobile outside the Center and then got out of the car and ran down the street for home.

In the short time he saw her it was very evident that she was psychotic and was in very poor contact. Apparently it is one of these situations where the family has recognized her illness for sometime, but kept her at home hoping that she would recover without treatment. Part of the difficulty has been the patient's own attitude as she kept insisting that there was nothing wrong with her and that she would be alright if people would only let her alone.

Her behavior steadily deteriorated and became increasingly agitated. She has been extremely restless constantly walking and dancing around the house. For the past few months she has been very reticent and fairly negativistic towards her mother, although she has not made any attempt to harm anyone or herself. She has been extremely restless and will go from one activity to another for a brief time and then suddenly lose interest in it. She does like to work in the flower garden, but here again her attention to the tasks is very short.

Her mood has been mostly depressed, but at times she will giggle and laugh inappropriately. Her sleeping habits have also varied a great deal with some nights that she will sleep soundly and others where she will be very restless and get up several times to make something to eat. She does not eat any regular meals, but lunches frequently throughout the day.

Dr. Beuning prescribed some tranquilizers for her but she has not been taking these as prescribed. She will take a tablet and break it up into small pieces and only eat a fraction of the pill.

Within the last week or two she has left the house and wandered a considerable distance without any apparent destination in mind. People have noticed her and recognized that something was wrong and have called the police. She has been extremely fearful of the police, however, and refuses to go with them when they approach her. They in turn have called the mother who has had to go and get her.

The patient's mother claims that she has always been in very good physical health with no special problems or severe illness. She had the usual childhood diseases but all of them seemed to have run a normal course without incident. Her development in the areas of speech, walking, eating and toilet training seemed to have been within normal limits. The mother did report an incident where she received a small scalp wound but she was seen by a local physician and he did not regard it as serious. Both the mother and sister claim that the patient seemed to have a fairly active normal social life throughout her school years. She was quite interested in sports particularly ice skating and dancing and presumably mixed well with her own age group. They felt she was fairly outgoing towards other people being quite interested in everyday affairs. Evidently, a good bit of her trouble started in high school and she only completed 2½ years. This was when the family noticed that she was becoming more socially withdrawn and was dropping one activity after another.

She has had some brief periods of employment working at the local hospital for a time and at a canning factory. While she enjoyed the work there, the mother does indicate that the patient was showing signs of pre-occupation and was probably not very productive. It is difficult to get an estimate of her intellectual functioning except that she always had very modest grades throughout her school years despite the fact that she worked quite industriously at her studies.

She was supposed to have done a good deal of dating throughout high school and even up until about a year ago. About five years ago she was quite serious about a man who was in military service and corresponded with him regularly. She also went with him to St. Paul and Chicago for several days without telling her family where she was going. When she returned from Chicago, she had broken off her affair with him but refused to talk about it with anyone in her family. Her sister feels that this may have been a fairly severe blow to her and may well have contributed to her later problems.

The family was not aware of any sexual history, but the fact that she has gone out with several men even during the time that she was quite ill suggests that she may have been somewhat promiscuous. It sounds as though she might be rather easily exploited in these situations. It was difficult to ascertain whether she has been hallucinating and delusional but a detailed description of her mannerisms and some of her peculiarities would certainly suggest that these may be present. She showed some paranoid tendencies when talking with Dr. Clappitt.

It was quite obvious that this young woman will not accept a voluntary admission and perhaps this would not be appropriate in any case. We suggested to her mother and sister that they arrange for commitment to Anoka and after discussing the matter they seemed quite acceptant of this proposal. In view of the fact that she has not been taking medication as prescribed and is obviously becoming badly decompensated, this seemed the best recourse. She has also been very neglectful of her personal appearance refusing to bathe and keep herself reasonably groomed. She has also become a source of some social embarrassment to the family as she will go down to the business section and wander around the streets aimlessly and becoming an object of concern to people who observe her.

She lives at home at 1014- 11th Avenue North with her p rents and a younger brother. She is the oldest of the children and has another married sister besides Mrs. Konz. She has not had any previous psychiatric attention and the mother was rather guilty and embarrassed about this. We spent some time talking about the hospital and it's facilities, and they had numerous questions reflecting some of the usual anxieties about committment to a state hospital. The mother was quite relieved to learn about the possibility of some activities for her commenting that the patient is musically inclined and does quite a lot of singing. She also has done some embroidering nd apparently is fairly good at this.

To summarize our clinical impressions, this appears to be a schizophrenic patie who has been gradually decompensating over a period of several years. There has been considerable social deterioration accompanied by a loss of interest in her personal appearance and hobbies. She displays a great deal of nervous agitation and a very short tension span that may be possibly effected by the present hallucinations or delusions but these are not particularly evident. Her thinking is obviously disorganized and her social judgement and self-awareness is very poor.

While she is not a pressing emergency with regard to committment, we feel that this should be done as soon as the arrangements can be conveniently made. Her family is quite cooperative and seemed quite understanding and sympathetic toward the patient.
