This Division objects to all matters relating to deductions and taxability.

It appears that the Federal Estate Tax deduction on the inheritance tax return includes penalty and interest. Only the tax principal is allowed as a deduction.

An error was made in the computation of interest due, in that such accrual of interest is limited to 6 years by statute, commencing 18 months after date of death. According to our figures, it appears that \$871.41 of interest was due.

The Northwestern National Life Insurance Company reported proceeds payable to the decedent's wife under policy No. 283352 in the amount of \$1,158.23. These proceeds were not included on the documents filed relative to this estate. Please submit a supplemental Schedule of Non-Probate Assets and an amended inheritance tax return to include this omitted asset and the correction of the above-cited discrepancies.

Wherefore, the State of Minnesota prays that the court does not designate the time and place of a hearing regarding the matters objected to in these objections and that no notice be given according to law, until specifically requested.


