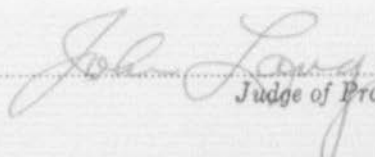

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

LOUIS E. SCHNEIDER

I, Louis E. Schneider, of the County of Stearns and State of Minnesota, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish and declare this instrument to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills and codicils by me made, as follows:

I

I hereby direct that all the expenses of my last illness and funeral be paid out of my estate.

II

I direct that the sum of Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) be paid to the Crosier Seminary at Onamia, Minnesota, for a series of Gregorian Masses to be read for the repose of the soul of my beloved wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, and for the repose of my soul.

III

I give and bequeath to my beloved wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, any homestead which I may own at the time of my decease, outright, as her absolute property, including in this devise any lands adjacent to said homestead which might be owned by me and used as a part thereof, irrespective of area. If my said wife does not survive me, this devise to her shall lapse and the property hereby devised shall be distributed as a part of the residue of my estate.

IV

All of my clothing, jewelry, ornaments, automobile or automobiles, books, household furniture and furnishings and personal effects of every kind and nature used about my person, home, or cottage at the time of my decease, I hereby give and bequeath unto my said wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, if she survives me. If she does not survive me, this legacy shall lapse, and I give and

bequeath the same equally unto my children who survive me, except that my son, Melvin, shall not be included herein.

V

If my beloved wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, survives me, then after providing for the above bequests, the residue of my estate shall be divided into two separate and distinct parts, designated as the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" and the "RESIDUARY TRUST" respectively.

A. (1) The "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" shall consist of assets of a value equal to one-half of my "Adjusted Gross Estate" as defined in Section 2056 of the United States Internal Revenue Code, less the sum of:

- (a) The value of property and interests passing from me to my wife under Articles III and IV hereof; and
- (b) The value of property and interests passing or transferred to my wife other than under this my Last Will and Testament, but only to the extent that said value is included in my gross estate for Federal Estate Tax purposes, and, at the date of my death, is allowable as and qualifies for the marital deduction under the United States Internal Revenue Code.

The "RESIDUARY TRUST" shall consist of the property constituting the residue of my estate.

- (2) The Executors of my will shall have complete discretion and authority in the allocation of assets in setting up the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" and the "RESIDUARY TRUST" and such allocation when so made shall be conclusive and binding upon all legatees hereunder and except for my executors no person interested in my estate shall have any right to participate therein; provided, however, no assets shall be placed in the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" which, at the date of my death, do not qualify as marital deduction property under said Code. The values to be used in selecting assets for the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" shall be those used by my Executors in the Federal Estate Tax Return filed for my estate and shall be controlling regardless of any subsequent adjustment of the value of any item of property or the amount of any deduction. If, however, the values used in the said Federal Estate Tax Return are fixed as of a date other than that of my death and the choice of such valuation date shall result in the disallowance of said bequest for the purposes of the said marital

deduction, then and only in such event and for the purposes of this Article only the valuation date to be used shall be the date of my death.

- (3) It is my intention that the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" created by this Article shall meet the requirements of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States, as interpreted by the Commissioner of Internal Revenue's regulations in effect from time to time, particularly Section 2056 thereof, so that the marital deduction will be allowed with respect to said trust in its entirety, and I therefore specifically direct and provide that the provisions of my will shall be construed and that said trust shall be administered so as to meet such requirements. I also direct that each and every other provision of this will, which, if applicable to said "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" created under this Article V, would result in failure of said trust to meet such requirements of the Internal Revenue Code, as interpreted by the Commissioner of Internal Revenue's regulations in effect from time to time, shall not be applicable to said trust. If for any reason whatsoever the provisions of this Article shall be held invalid under the laws of the State in which this will is originally probated, or if this bequest shall be held not to qualify for such marital deduction under the applicable provisions of the said Internal Revenue Code, then and in either of such events the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" shall consist of one-half of all of my property, real, personal and mixed, wherever situated, of which I may die seized, or over which I may have power of appointment at the time of my death; provided, however, that in setting aside such one-half of my said property for the purposes hereof, only such items of property which qualify for the said marital deduction shall be selected.
- (4) I then devise and bequeath said "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" to my Trustees hereinafter named to be held by it in trust and administered and distributed upon the uses and for the purposes set forth in sub-paragraph "C" of this Article.
- B. If, for any reason, the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" is determined to be invalid, then, and in such event, the property that would otherwise have been conveyed to said trust shall, in lieu thereof, be paid and distributed, absolutely and in fee simple, and free of all estate and inheritance taxes, as more fully set forth in Article VI below, to my beloved wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, if she survives me.
- C. In the event my wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, survives me, then I give, devise and bequeath all of said "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" and all of the assets comprising the same unto the ST. CLOUD NATIONAL BANK and DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER, as Co-Trustees to be by them managed, administered and the principal thereof and the income therefrom to be held and distributed as follows:

(1) During the life of my said wife,

- (a) My Trustees shall pay over and distribute all the income from the corpus of this trust from and after the date of my decease to my said wife in annual or more frequent installments, preferably, monthly, so long as she shall live. Any income from this trust earned or accrued prior to the death of my said wife and not distributed to her shall be paid to her estate.
- (b) In addition to said payments of income, my Trustees, after the receipt of the trust estate, may pay to my wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, from time to time such sums from the principal of this trust as it in its sole discretion deems necessary or advisable, in addition to any other funds known by it to be available to her for those purposes, to provide for her proper care, comfort, support, maintenance and general welfare. My said wife need not account to any person or court for any sums so received by her, and her receipt shall discharge the Trustee for any payments so made to her.

(2) Upon the decease of my said wife,

- (a) My Trustee shall pay over and distribute the entire corpus of the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST", or the part thereof then remaining, to such person or persons, including her estate, in such manner as my said wife may appoint to receive the same by her last Will and Testament, which general testamentary power of appointment hereby is given and granted unto her and shall be exercisable by her alone and in any event.
- (b) Any of the corpus of this trust which my said wife does not so appoint shall be paid over and distributed equally to my then surviving children and the then surviving issue of any child of mine who is then deceased, the issue of a deceased child, however, taking as by representation only the share which such deceased child would have received if living. The shares of my respective children and issue of deceased children shall be paid over and distributed to them outright; provided, however, that the share payable to any child or issue of a deceased child of mine for whose primary benefit there is then in existence, a trust created under other provisions of this my will, shall be added to such trust and thereafter be administered and the income and principal thereof be held and distributed as a part of such trust.

- D. If my said wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, does not survive me, then the provisions of this Article shall be wholly inoperative and no "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" shall be so set aside.
- E. In the event that my wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, and I die simultaneously, or if we die under such circumstances that it is impossible to ascertain which of us died first, then and in either of such events, and notwithstanding any statutory presumptions as to the order of our deaths, the property which would have been set aside in the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" or paid to her, as the case may be, pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph A of this Article, shall instead be transferred and conveyed, and the same is hereby given, devised and bequeathed to the Executors or the Administrators of her estate.

VI

I direct that all inheritances, estate, succession or other similar taxes of the United States of America or any state or territory thereof against my taxable estate or the properties constituting the same at the time of my decease or against the recipients thereof, including any such taxes against or arising out of the transfer or receipt of assets which are not part of my estate properly subject to probate, shall be paid out of the balance of my estate remaining after complying with the foregoing provisions of this my will and shall not be charged against the respective beneficiaries, and my Executors shall not seek reimbursement from anyone therefor.

VII

All of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate of every kind and nature, wheresoever situated and whether now owned by me or hereafter acquired, which for convenience may be called the "RESIDUARY TRUST", I give, devise and bequeath unto the St. Cloud National Bank and Dorothy M. Schneider, as Co-Trustees, to be by them managed, administered and the principal thereof and income therefrom held and distributed as follows:

A. During the life of my said wife,

- (1) My Trustees shall pay to my wife so much of the entire income of this trust in monthly or other convenient installments as my Trustees deem necessary or advisable to provide for her proper care, support and maintenance.

I direct that my Trustees be liberal in this interpretation of my said wife's needs and that my wife need not account to any person or court for any sums so received by her. Any income not disbursed to my said wife shall be paid equally to my children who survive me and have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years; provided, however, that if a child of mine is still a minor, or incompetent, my Trustees in their sole discretion may provide for the proper support, care and maintenance of such minor or incompetent before making any distribution of such income to any of my other living children.

- (2) If there are no principal funds available to my said wife in the "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST", then in addition to the net income from this "RESIDUARY TRUST" my Trustees may pay to her or apply for her benefit from time to time such sums from the principal of this "RESIDUARY TRUST" as my corporate Trustee in the exercise of its sole discretion deems necessary or advisable to provide for her proper care, support and maintenance.

B. After the decease of said Dorothy M. Schneider or upon distribution of my estate from probate if she predecease me:

- (1) My Trustee shall pay over and distribute the entire remaining balance of my trust estate, including both principal and any undistributed income, outright equally unto my children who are then surviving, and if any of them be then deceased then unto the issue of them; provided, however, that if any child of mine be then deceased leaving issue surviving at the time of such distribution, then such issue shall receive equally by right of representation the share which such deceased child would have received if living. If any child of mine has not then attained the age of twenty-one (21) years, the share of such minor child shall continue in trust for the benefit of such minor and be held and distributed in the same manner as provided in Paragraphs 2, 3, and 4 next hereinafter provided.
- (2) The share so allocated to the issue of a deceased child shall be paid over and distributed equally to such issue.
- (3) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the provisions of B (1) of this article, any share allocated for my son, Melvin C. Schneider, who is now a ward of the State of Minnesota, shall be set aside by my Trustees for his benefit during his lifetime and administered as provided above as though he were a minor. Upon his death any remaining balance held for his benefit shall be paid over and distributed in the same manner as provided for in Paragraph B (1) and B (2) of this Article.

- (h) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the provisions of B (1) of this Article, any share allocated for my daughter, Dorothy M. Schneider, shall be held in trust for her until she reaches the age of twenty-five (25) years and my Trustees shall pay to her so much of the net income therefrom and principal thereof as my Trustees in their sole discretion deem necessary and advisable to provide for her proper care, support, maintenance and education from time to time. Any income not distributed shall be accumulated and added to principal at convenient intervals. When Dorothy M. Schneider attains the age of twenty-five (25) years any remaining balance held for her benefit shall be paid over and distributed to her outright. At any time prior to her reaching twenty-five (25) years, provided, however, that she has attained the age of twenty-one (21) years, my Trustees at their sole discretion may pay to or for her benefit any or all of the principal and interest so held if they deem it advisable to do so.
- C. My Trustees in their discretion may make payments of any funds payable by the terms of this Article to or for the benefit of any minor or person under guardianship to the legal guardians of such beneficiary in the sole discretion of the Trustees exercised from time to time, without the intervention of any legal guardian, in any one or more of the following ways:
- (1) Directly for the maintenance, education and welfare of any such beneficiary;
 - (2) To the parent or natural guardian of such beneficiary; or
 - (3) To anyone who at the time shall have custody and care of the person of said beneficiary.
- The Trustees shall not be obliged to see to the application of the fund so paid, but the receipt of such person shall be full acquittance of the Trustees.
- D. My Trustees are hereby authorized in their discretion to determine finally, as to the trust or trusts created under the terms of this Article, all questions regarding allocations between principal and income with respect both to receipts and to expenditures, except that all premiums shall be charged and all discounts credited against or to principal, as the case may be, and not against or to income, and allocations between principal and income with respect both to receipts and to expenditures, except that all premiums shall be charged and all discounts credited against or to principal, as the case may be, and not against or to income and shall not be amortized; and except, further, that all dividends paid in stock of the paying corporation and all subscription rights shall be considered principal.
- E. No title in the Trust or Trusts created in and by this Article or in the income therefrom shall vest in any beneficiary, and

neither the principal nor the income of any such trust estate shall be liable for the debts of any beneficiary, and no beneficiary shall have any power to sell, assign, transfer, encumber or in any other manner to anticipate or dispose of his or her interest in any such trust estate created by the terms of this Article, or the income produced thereby, prior to the actual distribution thereof by the Trustees to said beneficiary.

VIII

If any time before final distribution of my estate or trust estate there shall not be in existence anyone who is, or might become, entitled to receive benefits therefrom as hereinabove provided, then upon the happening of such event any portion of my estate or trust estate then remaining shall be paid over and distributed outright unto my heirs-at-law, in the proportions and determined as though I had then died intestate, a resident of the State of Minnesota, fully seized and possessed thereof, but in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota now in effect relating to the descent of personal property of intestate decedents.

IX

It is an express condition of this my will, controlling over all other provisions hereof, that the duration of any trust hereunder in no event shall continue for a period longer than the lives of all of my said wife, Dorothy M. Schneider, and of any children of mine who may be living at the time of my decease, and the survivor of all of them, and twenty-one (21) years thereafter, at the end of which time the entire trust estate, principal and any undistributed income, shall be paid over and distributed outright unto the persons then entitled to receive the income therefrom or to have it accumulated for their benefit.

X

My Trustees shall have power and authority to do any act or thing reasonably necessary or advisable for the proper administration and distribution of each trust created by this my will. In order to facilitate the proper administration and distribution of each such trust, and except as may be in this

my last Will and Testament otherwise expressly directed, or required, and in extension but not in limitation of any power, right or discretion conferred upon my Trustees by this my will or by any present or future statute, decision, or rule of law, I hereby grant to my Trustees as to any properties, real, personal or mixed, at any time comprising a part of any trust hereunder, and without the necessity of notice to or license or approval of, any court or person, full power and authority, during the term of such trust and for purposes of division and distribution after its termination, in my Trustees' continuing sole discretion:

- A. To buy, sell and transfer real property, and to execute any and all contracts, contracts for deed, and deeds, and any and all instruments necessary or incidental to this right to buy and sell real estate.
- B. To retain cash or other assets, whether or not of the kind hereinafter authorized, for investment, for so long as they deem advisable, and to sell, exchange, mortgage, lease or otherwise dispose of the same for terms within or extending beyond the term of this trust and to receive from any source additional properties acceptable to it.
- C. To invest and reinvest in, or exchange assets for, any securities and properties it deems advisable, including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, common and preferred stocks, without being limited in the selection of investments by any statutes, rules of law, custom or usage; and to commingle for investment all or any part of the funds of this trust in any common trust fund or funds now or hereafter maintained by the Trustees.
- D. To collect, receive and receipt for any principal or income, and to enforce, defend against, compromise or settle any claim by or against the trust, and to vote, issue proxies to vote, join in to oppose any plans for reorganization and exercise any other rights incident to the ownership of any stocks, bonds or other properties of the trust estate.
- E. To hold assets in bearer form or in the name of the Trustees or in the name of its nominee or nominees without disclosing any fiduciary relationship, and to deposit cash funds as a general deposit in a special account in its own deposit department without liability for interest thereon; provided, however, that such assets and cash shall at all times appear as a part of the trust on the books of the Trustee.
- F. To make division or distribution, whenever herein required, in whole or in part in money, securities or other property, and in undivided interests therein, and to continue to hold

SCHNEIDER TRUST" created by Article V hereof shall meet the requirements of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States, particularly Section 2056 thereof, so that the marital deduction will be allowed with respect to said trust in its entirety, and I, therefore, specifically direct and provide that the provisions of Article V shall be construed and that said trust shall be administered so as to meet such requirements; but, unless necessary to meet such requirements, it is my desire that income from said trust to be distributed to my wife shall be deemed to be the net income therefrom determined by estate and trust accounting principles ordinarily applicable thereto. However, in the event it shall be necessary to do so in order to meet such requirements of the Internal Revenue Code, the provisions of said trust shall be construed to permit the amount of such income to be determined as being the gross income of said trust, or to be determined as for Federal Income Tax purposes, or to be determined in such other manner as may be necessary to meet such requirements of the Internal Revenue Code rather than in accordance with the estate or trust account principles which ordinarily would be applicable. I also direct that each and every other provision of this my will, which if applicable to said "DOROTHY M. SCHNEIDER TRUST" created under Article V, would result in failure of said trust to meet such requirements of the Internal Revenue Code shall not be applicable to said Trust.

Should my wife precede me in death or should we die in a common disaster, or should she be either unable or unwilling to act as the guardian of the person of my minor daughter, Dorothy, and my Son, Melvin, then, and only then,
