That he is the administrator and one of the transferees in the Estate of Helen Allen, Decedent, and that the said decedent is his sister;

That until the date January 1, 1960, when decedent withdrew from the same, affiant and decedent and their brother, Stephen Allen, operated the "Allen Farm" in Getty Township, Stearns County, Minnesota, as co-partners with each having a one-third share in the said partnership and the earnings therefrom; that by reason of serious illness of the said decedent she withdrew from the said partnership on said date;







Dear Gilman:

I just finished a difficult and unsatisfactory interview with your patient, Miss Jean Thorson, who was seen today in an emergency consultation.

With five staff members and three phone lines in operation, the inevitable has occurred. A Reverend Olson referred the patient to the Center through Dr. Lampitt, our Clinical Psychologist, who has been working with the Protestant Ministers during the past year. Ideally, we would hope the actual referrals would be directed to the Social Workers, when possible. While I accepted the referral for my emergency hour today, Dr. Lampitt was to have Reverend Olson determine who the family doctor might be and to make certain he understood and approved of the referral, etc. etc. As this came up following our staff meeting at 9:30 a.m., I did not communicate about this new emergency referral with Dr. Schnettler and he in turn talked with you and the school nurse about the same case, not realizing this was the emergency I had already agreed to see for today. Consequently, he set it up for tomorrow, as you know. I hope you understand this complication and I will tell you a bit about the patient.

The young lady was extremely tense and negativistic, refusing to acknowledge or answer 95% of all of my questions. She did inform me she did not want to come here, was uninformed that I was "a head shrinker", and that she did not need help. When I made an indirect reference to her brother and his death, the past week or so, she very angrily told me that was none of my business and she would not talk about it. After 15 or 20 minutes of this type of effort and failure, I completed the interview with a description to Reverend Olson of my impressions and recommendations, doing this in the presence of the patient.

I told him I thought this girl was in rather serious trouble, even though I had no immediate evidence that she was psychotic or out of contact. While she was schizoid and very disturbed, etc., I could not actually say she was psychotic on the basis of my observations. In view of her increasing somatic difficulties and the kind of picture I see in this girl, at this time, and in view of the family history, I would very strongly suspect this girl would be found to be psychotic or schizophrenic if thoroughly tested. In patient's that are generally this overtly angry and open about it, I feel the dangers of suicide is somewhat less than in the more withdrawn and more controlled depressed person. I believe she should be medicated, but do not

trust her to either take the medicine as directed and would hesitate to give her a prescription on an out-patient basis in the face of the attitude expressed in the office. In view of all of these findings, and in consideration of her attitude and the recent past events, I urged the Reverend to talk with the patient's mother rather frankly about proceeding with legal steps to have this girl committed to the Rhode State Hospital. I see this move as supportive and protective of the patient during this very critical time, whether she be psychotic or not. I have some fears that the mother will not see the daughter as being this ill ~~to~~ require such seemingly drastic steps, but urged the Reverend to direct the mother to our Social Workers with the hope we could help her with the decision and the details of commitment, etc.. In closing the interview I reminded the patient and the Minister of the fact that her anger and her telling me off 'so to speak', in no way closes the door to her getting out-patient help if and when she feels she can voluntarily accept it from the Center. She left the building angry and it is unlikely she will voluntarily seek assistance from us in the near future.

Regretting we were unable to be of more direct help to her but trust the parents will be able to follow through in bringing some therapy to this girl, I remain
