As a consequence, the Commissioner of Taxation will not object to the discharge of the representative.

The Court is also advised that the file of the above estate discloses inheritance tax payment(s) to date in the amount of \$ 46.30 , together with interest payment(s) in the amount of \$ 14.34 , for a total of \$ 60.64
