(5) In the administration of an estate of a non-resident decedent, the allowances received in the domiciliary administra-tion shall be deducted from the allowances under this section.

TO THE HEIRS AT LAW OF FREDERICK STREIT: FREDERICK STREIT Died on November 19th, 1963, leaving a Last Will and Testament, and a copy of the same has now been forwarded to all of the heirs. The Farm owned by said Decedent will now be decreed, by the Probate Court, as set forth under Clause Six of the Last Will and Testament. All of the remaining Assets have now been converted into cash, and all of the just debts of this Decedent have been paid in full, as well as all of the Special Bequests contained in the Last Will and Testament, which then leaves on hand a residue of \$14, 193.18, and each of the nine brothers and sisters. whether living or deceased, will receive the sum of \$1,577.02. As to the Brothers and Sisters who are still living, I am herewith sending to them a Probate Court Receipt for \$1,577.02, which Receipt is now promptly to be signed, and then forwarded to me. Upon receiving this Receipt, I shall forward to said individual heir a check for \$1,550.00, with the understanding that I shall retain the sum of \$27.02, out of which the State Inheritance Tax will be paid, and in approximately sixty days, the balance due will then be forwarded to said individual heir. Anton Streit will receive a check for \$1,300.00 and the sum of \$277.02 will be retained for his estimated State Inheritance Tax. Alois Streit will receive a check for \$700.00, and the sum of \$877.02 will be retained for his estimated State Inheritance Tax. As to the six children of Leo Streit, deceased, each of them is herewith receiving a check for \$262.84 and there is no State Inheritance Tax due upon their share. As to the four children of Joseph Streit, deceased, each of them are herewith receiving a check for \$394.25 and no State Inheritance Tax will be due upon their share. Enclosed herewith I am sending to each of you a newspaper clipping, which sets forth the date and time of hearing upon the Final Account. You are all welcome to attend this Hearing, but it is not necessary for you to be present unless you care to do so. This entire Estate has been handled in a proper and conservative manner, by Alois Streit, and if there are any further questions, please direct the same to him, or to the undersigned.
