INSTRUCTIONS

 - A. If there is a Minnesota probate proceeding (general administration, special administration, summary distribution, or petition for decree of descent), the return will be filed with probate court. If a tax may be due, or if a waiver of inheritance tax lien from the commissioner is needed, prepare the return in duplicate.
 - B. If there is no Minnesota probate proceeding, the return must be filed directly with the Department of Taxation, Inheritance and Gift Tax Division, 221 State Office Building, St. Paul 1, Minn.
 - C. If it is claimed that decedent was not a resident of Minnesota, an Affidavit of Non-Residence (Form D. of T. EG 1012) must be filed with this return. In such case, this return will disclose the detail of transfers of property having situs in Minnesota, and the total value of transfers in each class of property having situs elsewhere.
 3. **DETERMINATION OF TAX:** The court will determine the tax upon property included in the probate proceeding. The department will determine the tax upon the transfers disclosed in the return.
 4. The representative of the estate or other person executing the return is obliged to report all transfers which may be subject to tax. Each schedule of the return is to be construed as a question which must be answered by describing the transfers or by stating that there were none of this class, if such is the case.
 5. Satisfaction or waiver of inheritance tax lien upon the transfer of joint tenancy property can be obtained from the Department of Taxation by use of the Affidavit of Survivorship, Joint Tenancy or Remainderman, D. of T. EG 1018, which may be purchased from a legal stationer.

Barbara Funk being first duly sworn deposes and says that she is the Executrix in the Estate of Adam Funk and that this affidavit is made in support and in explanation of the item of real estate listed in Schedule I of the Inheritance Tax return.

Affiant further states that she is one of nine children of the deceased John Funk who died testate on July 24, 1917. That as such she inherited an undivided one-ninth interest in the real estate described in Schedule I of the Inheritance Tax return, subject to a life estate in her mother, Maria Funk. That her mother, Maria Funk, died on February 15, 1943. That the estate of John Funk was probated in 1944 and that a Final Decree was issued by the Probate Court of Stearns County on June 16, 1944 assigning an undivided one-ninth interest in said property to each of John Funk, Elizabeth Schwinghammer, Nicholas Funk, Rev. John B. Funk, Mathias Funk, Adam Funk, Sebastian Funk, Martin Funk and Barbara Funk, in fee simple, absolutely and forever. That thereafter, on June 6, 1945, John Funk and his wife, Elizabeth Schwinghammer and her husband, Nicholas Funk and his wife, Rev. John Funk, single, Mathias Funk and his wife, and Sebastian Funk and his wife, conveyed their undivided six-ninths interest to Adam Funk, Martin Funk, and Barbara Funk, as tenants in common for the sum of \$5000.00. That thereafter said real estate belonged to the last three persons named in undivided shares of one-third each.

That thereafter on January 4, 1947 Martin Funk died intestate leaving no issue and that on July 25, 1947 the Probate Court of Stearns County issued a Final Decree assigning an undivided one-eighth interest in the undivided one-third interest of said real estate to each of the remaining brothers and sisters, namely John Funk, Nicholas Funk, Elizabeth Schwinghammer, John B. Funk, Mathias Funk, Adam Funk, Sebastian Funk and Barbara Funk.

That thereafter on January 16, 1947 and for a nominal consideration each of the other heirs in the Estate of Martin Funk assigned their interest to Adam Funk and Barbara Funk as joint tenants. The joint tenancy was made effective as to all of their interests in this tract of land by a previous quit claim deed given by Adam Funk and Barbara Funk to Mathias Funk.

AFFIDAVIT

It is the claim of the affiant that she was the undisputed owner of an undivided one-half interest in said tract of land and that she inherited only the undivided one-half interest of Adam Funk by virtue of her survivorship under the joint tenancy deed.

The entire tract of land was sold by the affiant on a contract for deed dated December 21, 1962 for the sum of \$14,000.00.

Further affiant sayeth not except that this affidavit is made for the purpose of establishing the value of the inheritance recieved by Barbara Funk, as the surviving joint tenant on the tract described in Schedule I of the Inheritance Tax return in the Estate of Adam Funk.

- (2) When, except for one automobile, all of the personal estate of the decedent is allowed to the surviving spouse by clause (1), the surviving spouse shall also be allowed such automobile.
- (3) If there be no surviving spouse, the minor children shall receive the property specified in clause (1) as selected in their behalf;
- (4) During administration, but not exceeding 18 months, unless an extension shall have been granted by the court, or, if the estate be insolvent, not exceeding 12 months, the spouse or children, or both, constituting the family of the decedent shall be allowed such reasonable maintenance as the court may determine;
- (5) In the administration of an estate of a non-resident decedent, the allowances received in the domiciliary administration shall be deducted from the allowances under this section.

In all estates where there is a will the following rule applies to the spouse who has not consented to the will:

525.212 RENUNCIATION AND ELECTION. If a will make provision for a surviving spouse in lieu of the rights in the estate secured by statute, such spouse shall be deemed to have elected to take under the will, unless he shall have filed an instrument in writing renouncing and refusing to accept the provisions of such will within six months after the filing of the certificate of probate. For good cause shown, the court may permit an election within such further time as the court may determine. No devise or bequest to a surviving spouse shall be considered as adding to the rights in the estate secured by sections 525.145 and 525.16 to such spouse, unless it clearly appears from the contents of the will that such was the testator's intent.
