This 34 year old white married bartender from St. Cloud was seen to evaluate a complaint wherein he states "My wife and I have a sexual problem."

This man has a rather unusual history in that he is a diabetic and this has been known for about 9 months. He takes an oral capsule D.B.I. twice a day and states that if he eats his diet food properly and at regular times, he has not difficulty with his diabetes. Patient states that he does not drink alcohol even though he is a bartender and he works at the Eagles Club and has done so since March.

WORK HISTORY: Patient worked as a bartender at the Hub from June, 1961 to March, 1962 and changed jobs because of better hours. Prior to this he states he was a draftsman for the Minneapolis Honeywell Company in Los Angeles, California and this was dated December, 1960 to May, 1961. During this time the patient was estranged from his wife and apparently living in a common law marriage with a warmer and more receptive partner. Patient states that prior to this time he worked for two years in the State Hospital in Willmar, Minnesota as a recreational therapist in the arts and crafts building. His college history is that of attending St. Cloud State College for about three years, from about 1934 to 1937, he apparently did quite well the first year, the grades dropped somewhat the second year and he had major flunks in his third year, apparently just losing interest in required courses such as biology, math and physics. Patient was a speech therapist student and did study art. He has armed forces service from 1946 to 1947 in the Army, he was overseas in Korea in an artillery outfit and worked as a draftsman. He was again in the service in 1950 to 1953, this time in the air force as an artist illustrator.

COURT HISTORY: Patient states that he was court martialled a couple of times in service for being AWOL and this was primarily because he didn't care to return from his leaves on time. He states he has never been in a civil court or a criminal court, never been in jail, although he does recognize that he has an easy conscience and is able to put off major responsibilities and obligations without these things bothering him. Patient states that his mother died at age 39 of cancer of the "female organs", his father died of high blood pressure at age 49, the father apparently had been a yard clerk for the Great Northern Railroad. Patient states his parents were unsuccessful in carrying to term many of their pregnancies, and he states that the manner in which he was raised was not good, in that neither parents seemed to care much about him. He describes the parents as being interested in each other and rather loving with each other, as providing all his physical necessities and plenty of luxuries, but not providing much in the way of any genuine interest or limits.

to his activities. Patient contrasts this to his wife's up-bringing, he notes that she was raised as a Catholic whereas he was raised without religion, and apparently her father and mother were much concerned with controls, limits, right and wrong, etc. The patient's wife and he have not been much more fruitful than his parents, as they have only one child, age 4, and in view of the patient's diabetes now, the likelihood of having further children is remote.

THE SEXUAL PROBLEM: The patient states that the problem appears to be a sexual one, wherein his wife claims that he neglects her, (sexually) and states that she is exceedingly variable in her demands for sexual relations and that he cannot tune himself according to her variations. He states that she is frequently angry with him and at these times he cannot be sure of just exactly ^{how} she feels about him, therefore, he cannot approach her sexually. The implication is that if she is angry, he cannot trust her. Patient is not able to carry this further on to any masturbatory fantasies, however, he has apparently had some psychotherapy at the Willmar Mental Hygiene Center and this line of thinking might be quite close to the surface. The patient contrasts his sexual avoidance and mistrust of his wife with an affair he had a couple of years with an old girlfriend who herself was having difficulty with her husband in a sexual way. This girl apparently was quite warmly receptive and very much interested in sexual relations and during their tenure they would have relations at least once and usually twice a day. Patient's own description of his sexual relationships does not appear to be physiologically abnormal nor does he appear to be impotent in any particular way. Some of his intercourses are prolonged but he states that ordinarily they are not. He does not have premature ejaculations and he states that his wife has never had an orgasm. She, however, apparently enjoys sexual relations and is interested in them and she frequently accuses him of other women and he adds, "rightfully so", and I suspect that this does little or nothing to enhance his trust in her warm receptiveness. Patient's affair with the other woman apparently followed psychotherapy in his employment at the State Hospital and he may well have been mildly depressed at this time. The patient's own description of his character is that of a mild psychopathic flavor, he states that he lies frequently and that he lies about things that are not usually important or significant, primarily to his wife.

Patient seemed interested in therapy and very mildly depressed. It is significant that in their home, they are renting rooms to State College students of the female sex, and this may be a problem to his wife. Patient has one daughter, age 4, and apparently his relationship with the daughter is much better than with his wife, very probably to his wife's great chagrin.

→ **DIAGNOSTIC IMPRESSION:** Sociopathic personality.

PLAN: Patient's wife will be re-evaluated and a joint conference will be held. It is very likely that this patient will need psychology testing and some type of individual supportive psychotherapy of a brief duration, whereas his wife very likely will need a more prolonged and intensive psychotherapy.

Dear Mr. Schnettler:

I am enclosing some of the examination material pertaining to Mrs. Sandbo that you requested in your letter of December 30th. I will add a few notes concerning her progress in the Center.

Mrs. Sandbo was seen for therapeutic interviews by the social worker, and Mr. Sandbo started in treatment with me. The presenting problem centered around the marriage as will be seen in the attached writeups. During the interviews, Mr. Sandbo was rather cold and did not get himself involved in therapy. He talked a good deal about his marital situation but he did not say very much about his own problems. After about six interviews Mr. Sandbo quit coming to the Center and it was later learned that he had taken off first to Minneapolis and later to California. The case was accordingly closed and the final diagnosis was sociopathic personality, antisocial type.

Although the husband was cold, distant and had difficulty with sociopathic traits, it is clear that Mrs. Sandbo has also contributed to the marital difficulties. She has a rather obsessive preoccupation with religion and has attempted to use this in a demanding and controlling way towards her husband. She was also immature, dependant and clinging. She used poor judgement in the way she tried to deal with her marital problems and gave herself up to tantrum-like acting out. It was necessary to confront her with the possibility that she might have to be hospitalized before she was able to control some of the acting out.

There is no doubt that this girl is quite disturbed and the prognosis is guarded. In addition to her personality difficulties, she is struggling with depressive feelings in relation to her husband's threatened desertion which now has become a fact.
