ARTICLE I.

I hereby direct that all my just debts and the expenses of my last illness and funeral be paid out of my estate. I further direct that all inheritance, estate, succession or other similar taxes of the United States of America or any state or territory thereof against my taxable estate or the properties constituting the same at the time of my decease or against the recipients thereof, including any such taxes against or arising out of the transfer or receipt of assets which are not part of my estate properly subject to probate, shall be paid out of the residue of my estate as a part of the expenses of administration and shall not be charged against the respective beneficiaries, and my Executors shall not seek reimbursement from anyone therefor.

I give and bequeath \$1000.00 cash to the Holy Cross Lutheran Church, St. Cloud, Minnesota; and to all my grandchildren, then living, the sum of \$1000.00 cash to each of them.

All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate, real and personal, of every kind and nature and wheresoever situate and whether now owned by

ARTICLE IV.
