



The following is a report of a psychiatric consultation I have done on this date in the Stearn's County Jail with the above captioned patient.

This 39 year old white married farmer was mildly anxious and quite aloof in his manner of relating and answering questions, however, he remained superficially cooperative and was able to warm up very slightly toward the end of the 40 minute interview when I reassured him I had no intention of attempting psychiatric treatment with him. Mr. Schmid gave the correct and proper answers to all mental status questions and the picture he presented, only upon questioning, was that he had been jailed after drinking one day only, probably by his father, but he really didn't know exactly whom. He states that he did not know of any crime he had committed or any law he had broken, although he guessed that drunkenness was against the law in that some legal charge must have been made and he was in jail. Mr. Schmid never volunteered more information than he could slip by with and he stated that he really knew of no reason for a psychiatric exam. He stated that he was nervous and worried, and this he related to a busy work season on his mortgaged farm and a need for him to be there performing his chores.

The question of the presence of any mental disorder was thoroughly reviewed and I can find no evidence of psychiatric disease. Mr. Schmid appears to have what superficially looked like ideas of reference in regard to his family and this in relationship to the reason for his being jailed, now the second time within a year. He feels slightly persecuted in this respect when asked directly about this and stated that he knows of no reason for the jailings. He specifically and in an itemized fashion, was able to deny any misbehavior, any assault or neglect or marital problems and stated that he has never abused any of his children. When it was explored with him that, first in February, 1963, his wife had him jailed, now again another member of his family, probably, had him jailed and that his assertion of no difficulty is hard to add up to the recourse his family has taken, the patient was simply silent and could not be led to discuss the matter further.



He was able to relate that he had a sober period with A. A. and a year ago a good working summer, staying dry. After his fall work was done, he felt that he could competently hold his liquor and that he was controlling his drinking by will power and not through his A.A. steps, and he relates in November of last year, he again resumed drinking. He apparently has been hospitalized several times for drying out, was jailed in February of this year, and the charges dropped after he voluntarily went to Willmar, however, he did not stay a full 60 days and as he was a voluntary patient, this could not be pushed longer than the 24 days that he did stay. He apparently resumed drinking shortly after leaving Willmar in that he needed another drying out hospitalization early in April of this year.

My diagnosis is sociopathic personality, addiction, alcohol, chronic.

My recommendation would be that this patient be committed by a court order to the Willmar Alcoholic's Rehabilitation Center and following 60 days of being dry, that some type of mandatory provision be made for him to attend A. A. If no legal recourse can be made for him to attend A. A. and if some type of settlement cannot be obtained between his family and Mr. Schmid, my assumption is that he will very likely continue drinking. I see this patient's mistake in terms of his illusion that after a sober period he has learned enough so that he can drink socially and with a degree of temperance and not get in trouble with alcohol. This obviously is not true and until he again takes and follows A.A.'s first step, I see no sobriety in store for him outside of one of society's correctional institutions. If his behavior is different from what he says, notably irresponsible and assaultive, the decision to use one of society's corrective institutions as a method of controlling his sociopathic behavior should rest with his family.
