GREETING:

Now Therefore, Reposing full faith and trust in your competency, ability, and integrity, these letters testamentary are issued to you by the court, authorizing you to execute and carry into effect the said will of said decedent, according to the true intent thereof; and granting unto you all the powers, duties and responsibilities incident to said trust, in substance as follows, to-wit:
