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I tested Alma Olson at her home Friday, July 2, 1926. Used a Stanford Revision of the Binet, obtaining a mental age of 10 years, no months; intelligence quotient 62.

As Alma stated it was necessary to use Norwegian in speaking to her mother, thought possibly the vocabulary test might not be altogether fair to her. However, she passed the vocabulary tests of year 8 and year 10, doing better in the tests that required the use of speech than she did as a whole. Failed in the arrangement of weights and in drawing the two designs from memory. Alma passed all of the tests in year 8, four in year 9, two in year 10, four in year 12 (one of these being rather questionable as to whether it was really passed) and none in year 14. There was nothing in any of the tests that was unusual in any way. The responses were more or less typical of the feeble-minded person. In the test requiring at least sixty words to be named in three minutes, Alma named twenty in the first half minute and word lessened until in the last minute she named only 3, rather typical of a minded person. All told she could only get fifty four words. While Revision of the Binet is only supposed to test absolute intelligence, test, which may be considered free association, there is some times evidence of a peculiar twist of the mind. The words named by Alma, however, were simply the objects in sight or the common things that she knew. There seemed also to be no particular inhibitions, nothing to indicate that she was in any way mentally unbalanced. Considering the history of the girl it would seem she should be under very definite supervision.

I would recommend that she be committed to the guardianship of the State Board of Control and ende to understand clearly what guardianship means, both as one of helpfulness and friendliness and also one exerting certain restrictions. Further, that she be given to understand that if she cannot obey these restrictions outside of an institution she will have to be sent to Fairbank in order to do so.

That the said alleged feeble-minded person will not appear in said Court voluntarily, and that it will be necessary to issue a warrant to bring her before the Court.

Your petitioner states on information and belief as follows:

The said Alma Olsen was born in North Fork Wash
; is about 27 years of age and the parent of one children.

That her residence and place of legal settlement is Stearns County, Minnesota. (If not a resident of Minnesota, set out as fully as possible where h. came from, how long has been in this State and in the County.)

That no restraint has been employed.

That the supposed cause of feeble-mindedness is unknown

The patient has been treated by Dr Tennyson, Dr Pilon, Dr Moynihan

WHEREFORE, Your petitioner prays that the above named Court will make due inquiry into the matter, and to that end that said alleged feeble-minded person may be brought into said Court and examined as to said alleged feeble-mindedness, and if found to be feeble-minded that he be sent to a state institution in accordance with the statutes in such case made and provided.



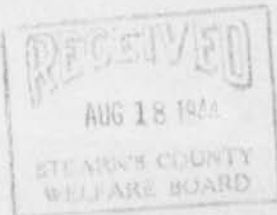



I tested Alma Olson at her home Friday, July 9, 1926. Used a Stanford Revision of the Binet, obtaining a mental age of 10 years, no months; intelligence quotient 62.

As Alma stated it was necessary to use Norwegian in speaking to her mother, thought possibly the vocabulary test might not be altogether fair to her. However, she passed the vocabulary tests of year 8 and year 10, doing better in the tests that required the use of speech than she did as a whole. Failed in the arrangement of weights and in drawing the two designs from memory. Alma passed all of the tests in year 8, four in year 9, two in year 10, four in year 12 (one of these being rather questionable as to whether it was really passed) and none in year 14. There was nothing in any of the tests that was unusual in any way. The responses were more or less typical of the feeble-minded person. In the test requiring at least sixty words to be named in three minutes, Alma named twenty in the first half minute and gradually lessened until in the last minute she named only 3, rather typical of the feeble-minded person. All told she could only get fifty four words. While the Stanford Revision of the Binet is only supposed to test absolute intelligence, this test, which may be considered free association, there is some times a peculiar twist of the mind. The words named by Alma, however, were all objects in sight or the common things that she knew. There seemed also to be no particular inhibitions, nothing to indicate that she was in any way mentally unbalanced. Considering the history of the girl it would seem she should be under very definite supervision.

I would recommend that she be committed to the guardianship of the State Board of Control and made to understand clearly what guardianship means, both as one of helpfulness and friendliness and also one exerting certain restrictions. Further, that she be given to understand that if she cannot obey these restrictions outside of an institution she will have to be sent to Paribault in order to do so.







GREETING:

Whereas, You have been appointed execut or of the last will and testament of the above named decedent, by the order of this court, and have duly qualified as such:

Now Therefore, Reposing full faith and trust in your competency, ability and integrity, these letters testamentary are issued to you by the court, authorizing you to execute and carry into effect the said will of said decedent, according to the true intent thereof, and granting unto you all the powers, duties and responsibilities incident to said trust, in substance as follows, to-wit:
